

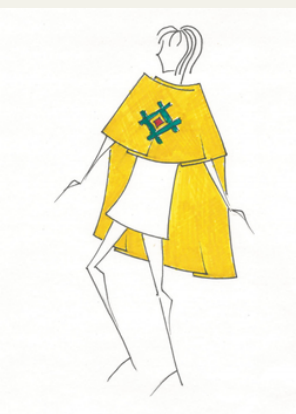
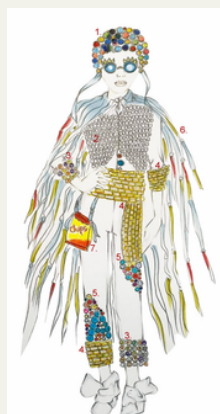

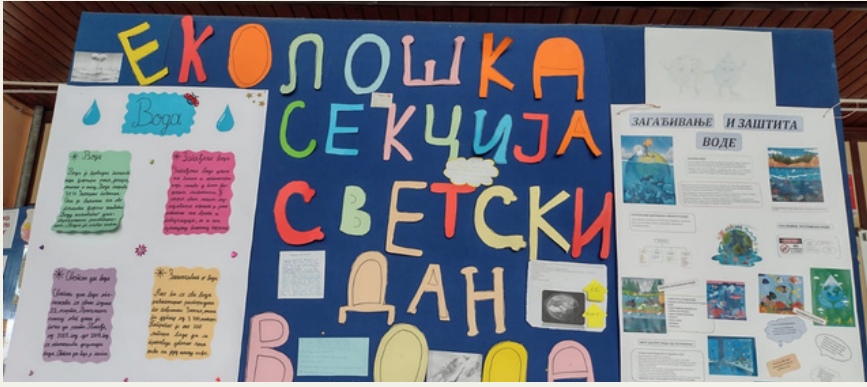
## Climate heroes costumes ready

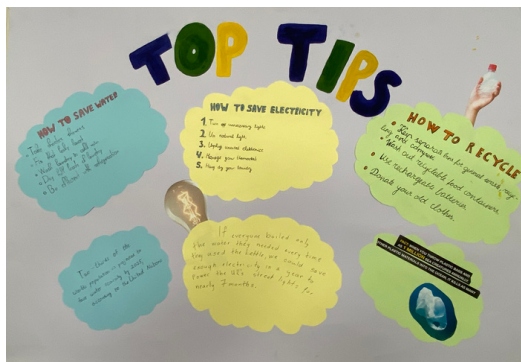




# SOLARWAVE - LET`S SAVE THE PLANET!
