Margherita di Savoia


This assessment quiz was carried out among the four Slovenian students that were guests of the Italian peers in March 2022 at the end of the mobility week.


- Welcoming and farewell ceremonies




- The Castle del Monte



Half of the students found the visit to the Saltwork Museum more interesting than the other two visits.


5 which was the most interesting task you did?

Three out of four students liked the cooking workshop, preparing the traditional orecchiette.


6 which was the most challenging task you did?

- Answering the quiz about the project


Half of the students found that the task concerning the saltpan fauna was the most challenging of all.

When they were asked about the thing they learnt that first comes to their mind, two of them answered that it was the thermal spa offer, one mentioned the fact that there are the biggest European saltworks in Margherita di Savoia, and one remembered how well the Cicerones guided in the museum.

Three students out of four could name the most common birds from the salt pans of Margherita di Savoia, one mentioned only three. The (pink) flamingo was the most frequent answer.




They all answered correctly that saltworkers lived in straw houses in Margherita di Savoia.




Only one student remembered the correct size of the saltworks in Margherita.




All students knew that the salicornia / glasswort is common in all the salpan environments of the countries involved in the project.




The students all learnt the phases of the salt production well.


- That Puglia has very good food and that the salt pans of Margherita di Savoia are the largest in Italy
