
NUMERACY WEEK 2






“Aris, the Shoemaker” by Evgenios Trivizas

Author visit in our school


The author Konstantia Sotiriou presented a story with numbers to students of C' Class and helped them to write their own story. Students illustrated their story with drawings.

The teacher suggested to help him with Maths, but Zafiris refused! She was pleased with this answer, but surprised too.


