AIMS
THE AIM OF THE PROJECT IS TO RESEARCH THE GENERAL STRING FROM THE PAST THAT CONNECTS ALL PARTNER COUNTRIES AS ONCE BEING PARTS OF THE ROMAN EMPIRE. THE ROMAN EMPERORS LEFT TRACES OF THEIR CULTURE, LITERATURE, SOCIAL LIFE, SPORT, ARCHITECTURE, RELIGION, LANGUAGE, AND TRADE IN THE PARTNER COUNTRIES, WHICH LEAD TO CREATION OF A MUTUAL CULTURE.
DURING THE WORKSHOPS THE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WILL FOLLOW THESE FOOTPRINTS IN ORDER TO PERCEIVE THE SHARED PAST.
THE PROJECT WILL ALSO CREATE OPPORTUNITIES FOR OUR STUDENTS TO IMPROVE THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH AND THE UNDERSTANDING OF EUROPEAN UNION CITIZENSHIP.

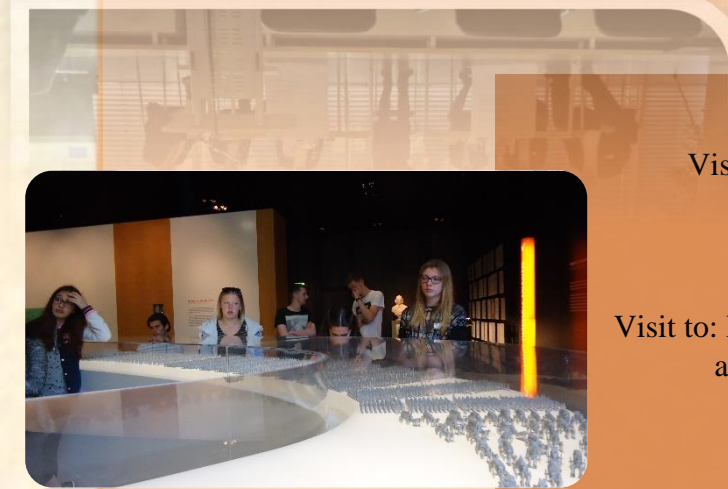

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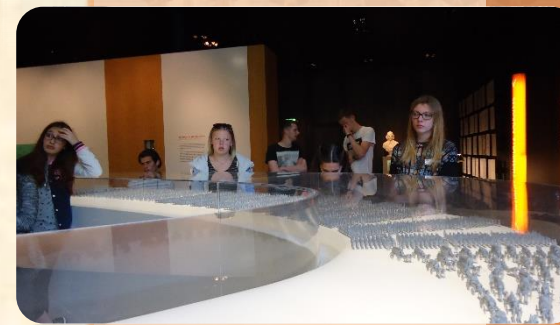
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
