According to the application form of the Project (2015-1-PT01-KA219-012951_1)Mini Entrepreneurs at school, from 03 to 07 October 2016, took place in Aydın, Turkey , the 2nd transnational meeting, being present the partners from Portugal, Romania, Italy and Turkey. According to the program prepared for the meeting, the following activities took place:

03.10.2016

The participants arrived at the Park Otel, did a little sightseeing in the city and had welcome dinner altogether.

04.10.2016

Partners were given their name tags and hand-outs materials. Esin Şevik welcomed project partners and presented the agenda of the meeting. Each partner school presented and evaluated their portfolios use. After lunch, all participants evaluated the first year of project. They discussed about activities' positive and negative aspects.

Activities which had been done since the last meeting (from April, 2016 to October, 2016) were presented by the contact persons of each school. The presentations of Estonian and German partners were presented by Maria da Graça Carvalho, the Coordinator, to whom the works had been sent in advance.

The Italian coordinator presented a video about the process of making the Ebook with the adventures of E & S.

05.10.2016

The participants visited Mersinbeleni İlkokulu. They had meeting with all school teachers. They interviewed English teachers, discussed about portfolios with all school teachers. The participants had cultural visits to Ephesus, Selcuk, Virgin Mary's House, Şirince, Kuşadası.

06.10.2016

The partner schools planned the local and international activities of the 2nd year.

- Go on with dissemination activities.
- Go on working with personal and other countries' ideas;
- Upload the materials in etwinning;
- The Italian partner sends all their materials from the web page to the coordinator;
- Work with the teams for the creation of the mini enterprises;
- Romania sends the Coordinator the program 2 weeks before the meeting.
- The Italian team presented the project of the website. According to the Italian Coordinator, due to technical reasons, only he has access as Administrator of the site. So, it was decided to send the materials for the web page to the Coordinator who will check and send them to the ICT responsible (the Italian partner), for being published in the website;

It was decided to share the lodging costs by all the partners, with implementation money.

After lunch, the participants visited Mersinbeleni İlkokulu. They evaluated the impact of this project on students and teachers.

07.10.2016

In Mersinbeleni İlkokulu, the participants watched a folklore show by Mersinbeleni Primary School students.

They decided that the 2nd newsletter of the project would be prepared by the Turkish partner in two weeks.

Each participants evaluated the 2nd transnational meeting. They shared their ideas.

The Coordinator called the attention to the necessity of reading very carefully the financial contract, as all the rules to be followed are there.

During lunch, it was presented not only traditional Turkish food, but also Turkish customs.

After lunch, the participants visited Koçarlı Adult Education Center. The responsible for the center welcomed the group to whom were served juice and Baklava – a typical sweet.

The group visited an exhibition of products made by women entrepreneurs, and some of these products were offered to all the participants.

There was certification of all participants of the meeting in a farewell dinner, where local products were tasted.
