

From Majority to Erveryone, Erasmus+ project 2018-1-SE01-KA229-039176 Learning/Teaching/Training event in Landvetter, 4 – 8/2 2019

Project report

The first Learning/Teaching/Training event for the project was organised in Agnebacken preschool in Landvetter in Harryda Municipality in Sweden between 4th and 8th of February 2019. The focus question for the meeting was “*How to use the meal to create diversity and equality*”



Monday 4th of February

The participants met in Agnebacken preschool in Landvetter. The group was welcomed by Annika Gry, director of the Department of Development, Leisure and Multilingualism in Harryda Municipality, Lotta Lundqvist director of Agnebacken and Hagen preschools and Maria Stendahl, director of Salmereds and Mysten preschool.

Crister Carlsson, coordinator of the project, informed about Mobility Tool and Lotta Lundqvist informed about a “Literature Boost in preschool” project.

Lunch at Mysten preschool and then, after a walk in the snowstorm to Landvetter cultural house, each participating preschools reported from their work with the focus question for the meeting.



The day ended with a workshop about how to use the different senses when investigating food.

Tuesday 5th of February

The group was split in smaller groups and did a study visit and a job shadow activity in Hagen, Mysten and Agnebacken preschools during the time until lunch. Then lunch together with the children in the different preschools.

After lunch Siv Jirblom, from the UFF department in Harryda municipality, held a lecture about “Relational Pedagogy”. After the lecture there was a long discussion about the lecture.

In the afternoon there was time for reflection in the national groups.



Wednesday 6th of February

The whole day had activities planned at Tellus Recourse Centre in Molnlycke.

First there was a meeting with famous female scientists in a dramatized form. Then there were different workshops at the Recourse Centre about chemical experiments, programming and math.

After lunch the group visited the recycling centre AterC, which offer recycled material and natural material for the pedagogic activities in preschools and schools in Harryda municipality. The group participated in a workshop at AterC.



After the workshop the plan was to listen to Annette Hellman from the University of Gothenburg but she has become suddenly ill so the time was spent with reports and discussions from the study visits and jobshadowing.

The day ended with a “Swedish Buffet” at Tellus Recourse Centre.

Thursday 7th of February

The Thursday was arranged the same way as Tuesday with study visits and jobshadowing in new preschool groups. The groups ate their lunch at the preschools together with the children.

During the afternoon there was time for discussions and reflections in the national groups.

Friday 8th of February

The day began with reports from the jobshadowing and study visits at the three preschool, Mysten, Hagen and Agnebacken. The results were discussed.

Then there was time for evaluation of the Learning/Teaching/Training event in Harryda Municipality. A set of questions were discussed in national groups and reported for all.

The discussions continued after the lunch and the day ended with information and discussions of the next LTT event in the project that will take place 21 -25 October in Guastalla in Italy.
