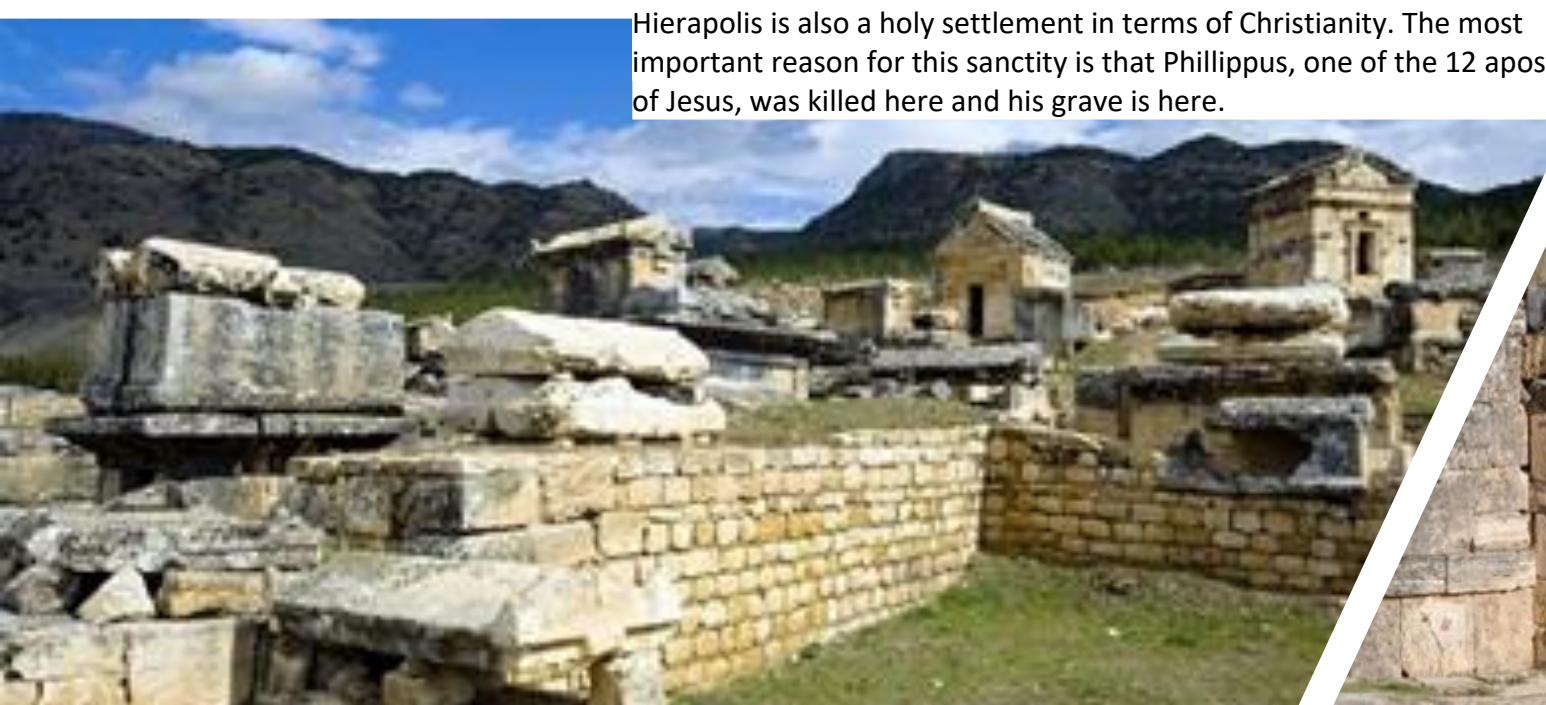


Travertines: The dazzling white calcite cliff of Pamukkale formed from calcium deposits left by the area's hot springs.

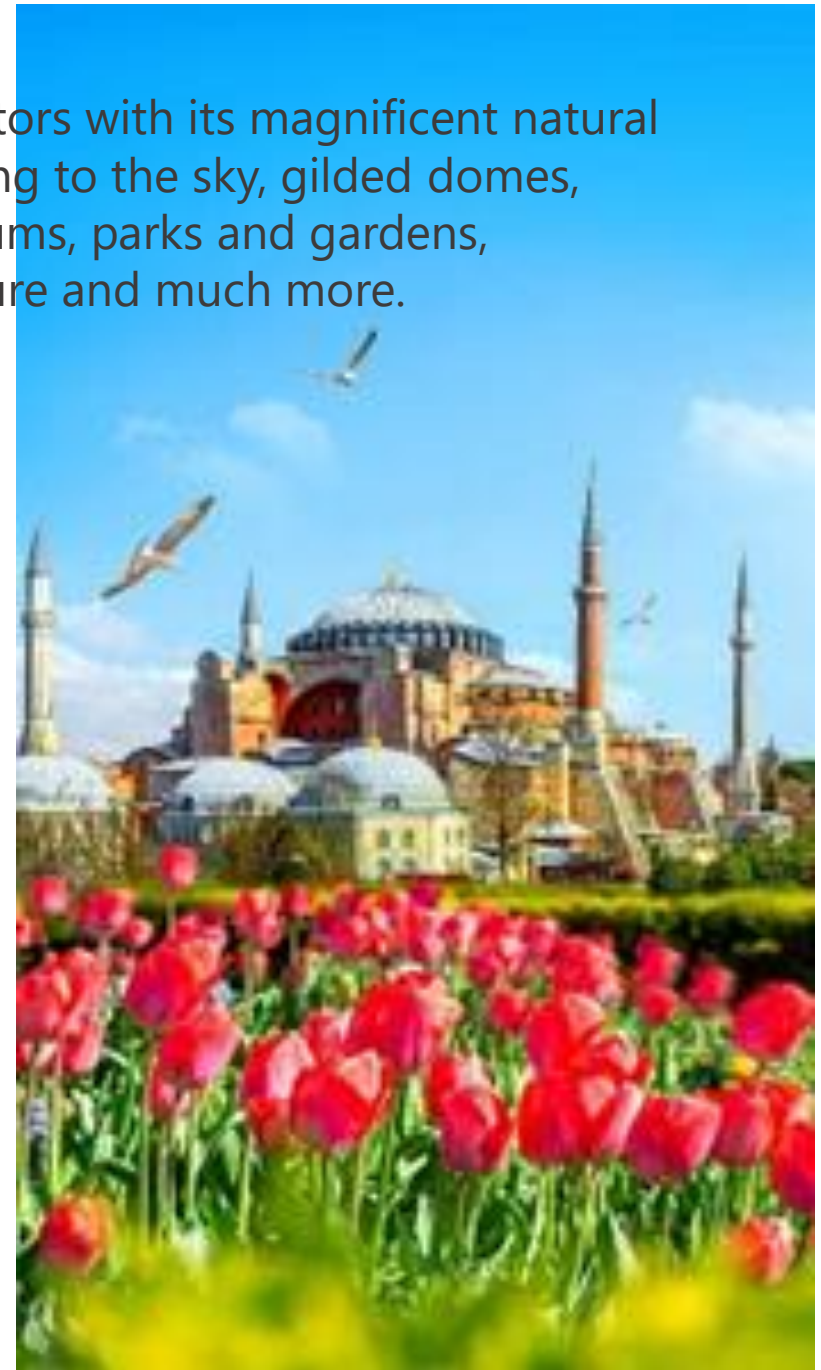
