


2nd Short-term joint staff training events




Koutouki Cave (Paiania)

Discovered in 1928 by local residents, it is a very beautiful cave. During the 1960s, efforts were undertaken to make the site accessible to visitors. Located on the east side of Ymittos, above Peania, its underground route of 350m guides the visitor amongst stalagmites and stalactites, creating a magical landscape.
