




MOTIVATION TO TAKE PART IN THE PROJECT




OPPORTUNITIES THAT MIGHT BE BROUGHT




PREDICTION ABOUT WHAT THEY WILL ENJOY THE MOST






2 - How often do you use the computer?




3 - How much time do you spend per day on the web/internet?







They are more confident in the participation of forums or social networks.




Language Skills




2 - How do you evaluate your skills in English according to the options below?




3 - Where have you learned your English?
