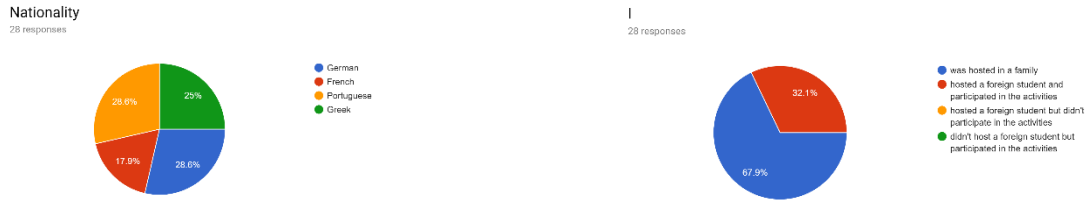


"Off the Beaten Tracks"

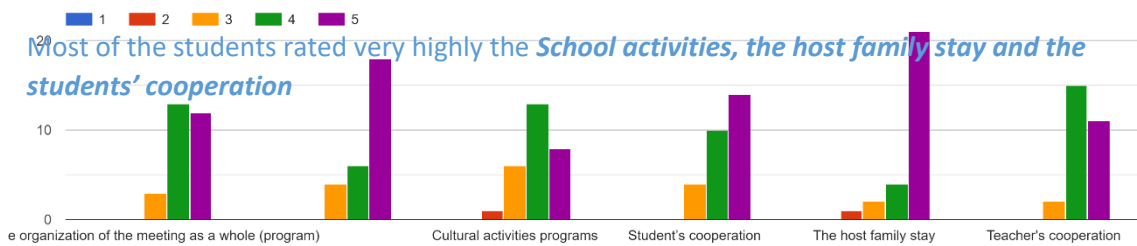
Mobility in Neu-Isenburg, Germany

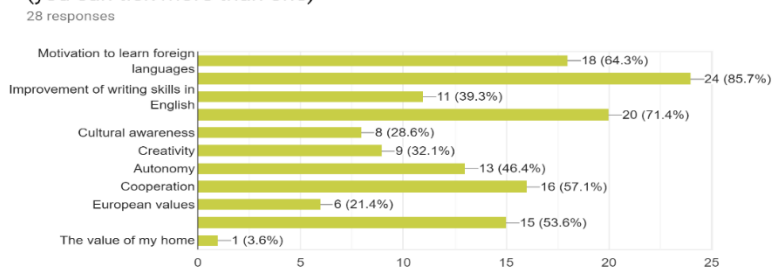
ORGANISATION

1. On a scale from 1(not good) to 5 (excellent) how would you evaluate:



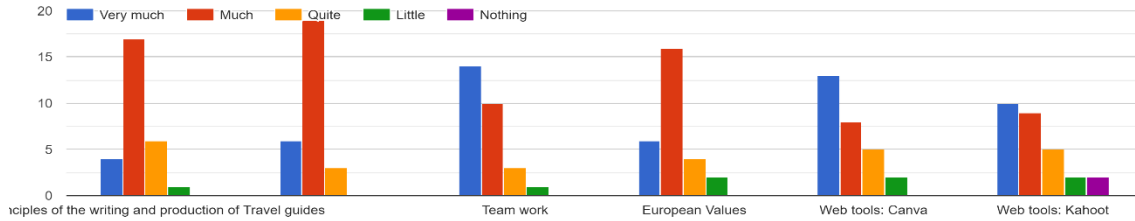
PROJECT GOALS

(you can tick more than one)



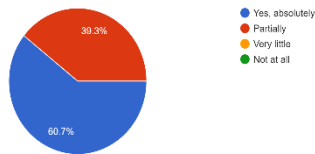
The majority consider they have **improved their speaking skills and the ability to communicate with foreigners. The motivation to learn foreign languages and the interest to participate in projects increased.**

2. How much have you learnt about the following subjects?



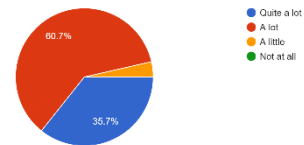
3. Do you feel the activities were useful?

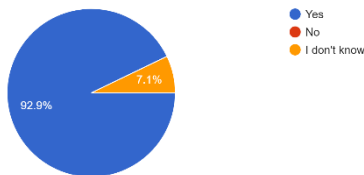
4. How much did you involve yourself in the activities?

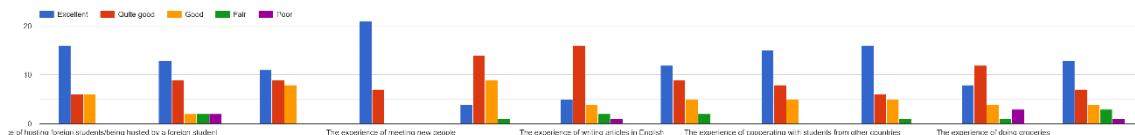
5. Following your participation in the project, do you think that you are willing to participate in other activities?

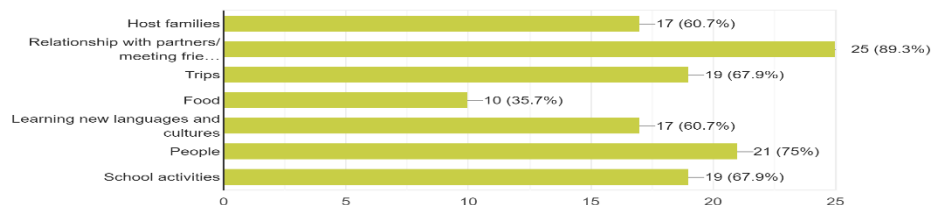
EXPERIENCE
