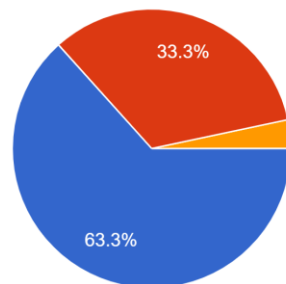




## Erasmus + "Off the Beaten Tracks" Mobility in Epernay, France

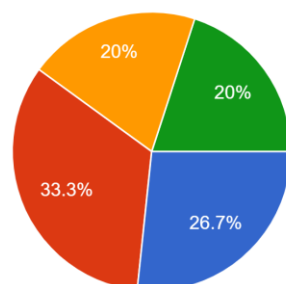

- didn't host a foreign student but participated in the activities

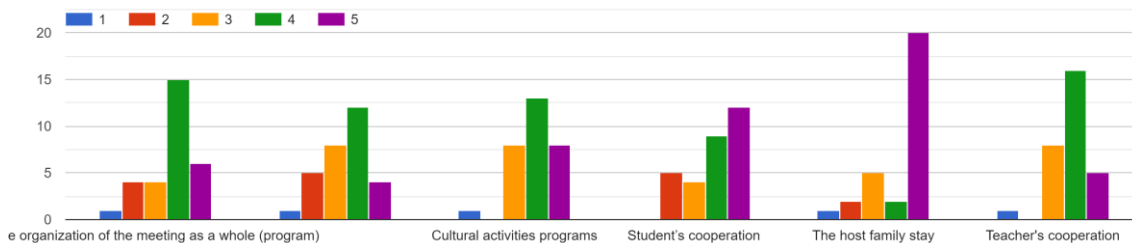

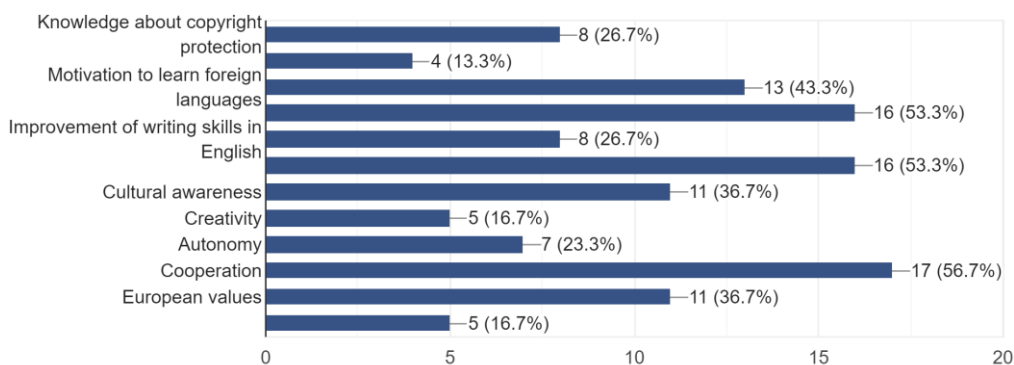
1. On a scale from 1(not good) to 5 (excellent) how would you evaluate:

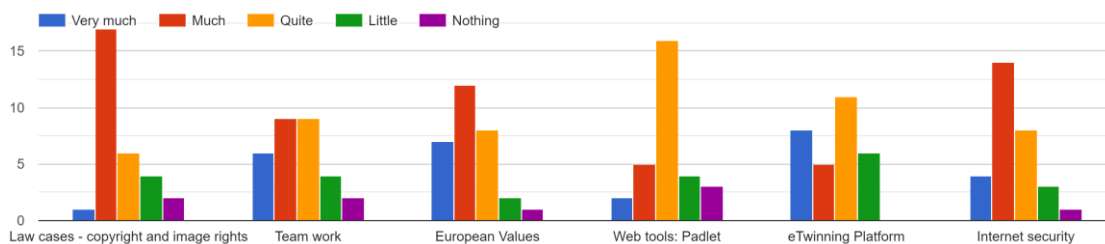
1. What aspects/items do you consider you have developed in this meeting? (you can tick more than one)

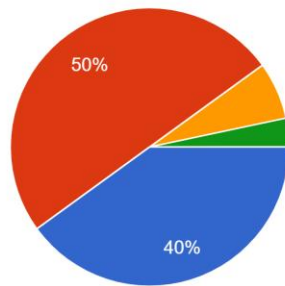
**Cooperation, ability to communicate with foreigners and improvement of speaking skills in English are considered the most developed in this meeting.**

3. Do you feel the activities were useful?

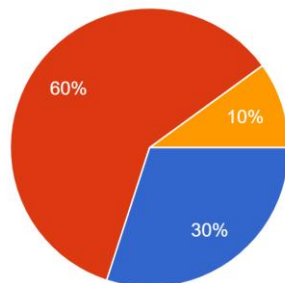

4. How much did you involve yourself in the activities?

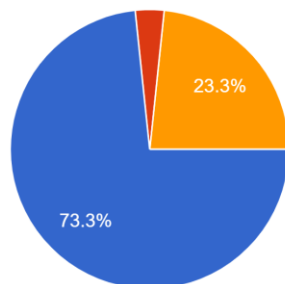

5. Following your participation in the project, do you think that you are willing to participate in other activities?

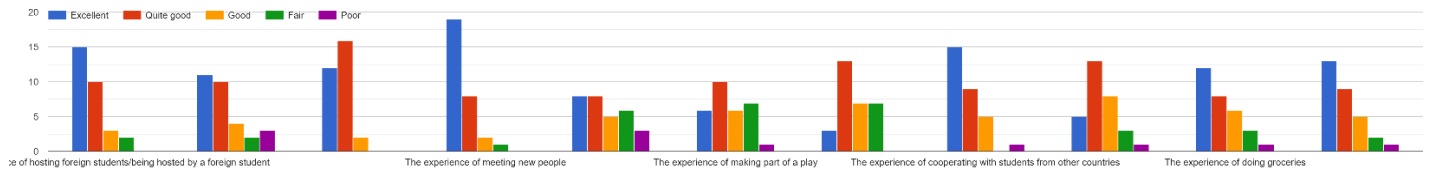

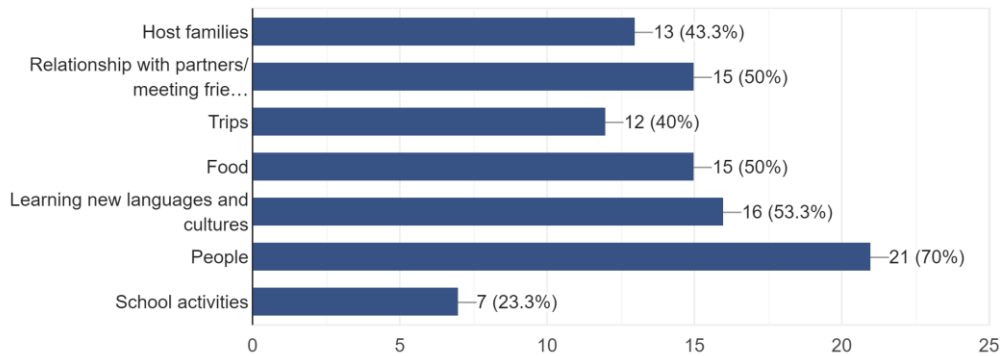

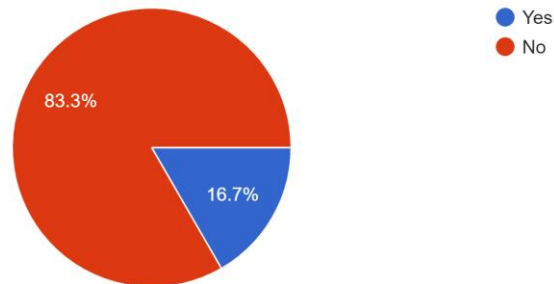
