27.10.2019.

The project coordinator Alzbeta Krupova and Nusret Camsi presented project “Everything can be recycled, except the Earth”.

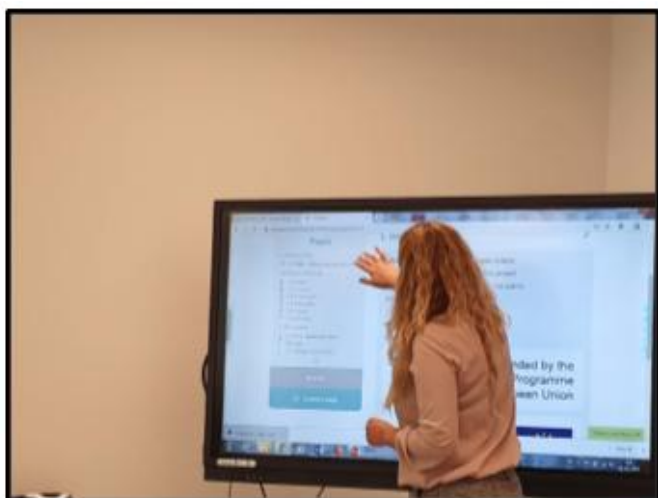


Each school had prepared presentation about their country, town/city and school.

The partners were guided tour of the school by students (tour guides). They were shown school itself - classrooms, grounds, sport hall, project corner – dedicated to project.

Cultural event “How to get Latvian?” was arranged for all participants to raise awareness about Latvian folk traditions and culture by representatives of Riga Latvian Society House.



Working dinner took place in Baltezers, Vanaga Ligzda. After dinner all teams went back to the hotel.

29.10.2019.

After breakfast, all participants got on the bus and went to Adazi town. At 9.00 we visited SIA «RUBRIG» – floor covering company which made safety rubber flooring from recycled tires.



Students performed the concert and Fashion Show “All from recycle materials” for participants of the project.

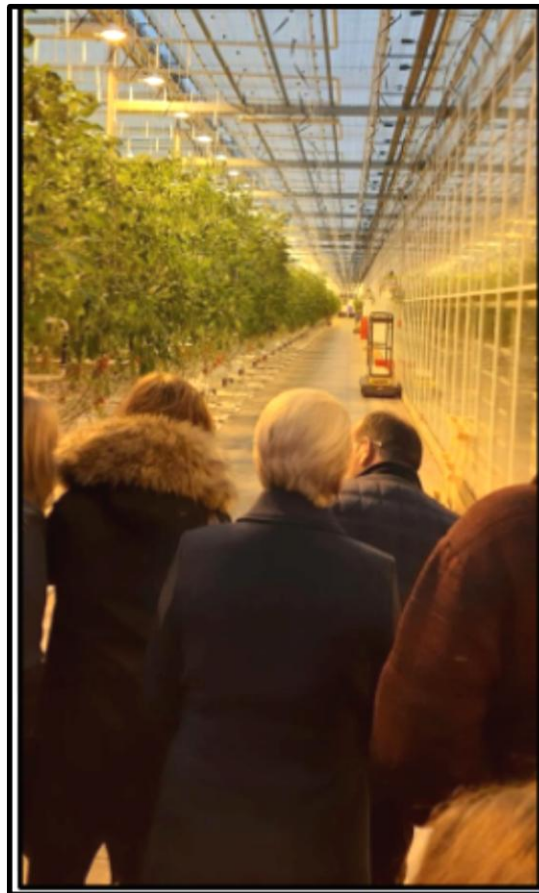




At 11.30 we had the work session. The discussion was about project schedule and meeting dates. The meeting schedule was accepted by all participants.



In the afternoon, at 13.00 project participants went to the biggest waste landfill in the Baltics- Getlini in order to learned about waste management and issues. Participants were shown the principles of waste management and the greenhouses, powered by locally produced energy.



After 16.00 all participants had a free time. Historic Old Riga was explored in the evening.

30.10.2019.

Project partners arrived at Adazi school and took part in two workshops.

The first workshop started at 9.30. It was the stop-motion animation workshop organized by representatives of “Multikulten”. Participants made short films about recycling from materials, which had been reused.



The second workshop started at 14.00. It was organized by Latvian Fund for Nature representative. The creative environmental education workshop was dedicated to waste problems. Also, partners discussed the impact of these topics on society and their daily work at school and how to implement it in the learning process. Participants made jewellery from plastic bottles.



At 19.00, we had dinner in the restaurant Rīgas Pērle, after what went back to the hotel.

31.10.2019.

We all went to the school with the bus. At 9.30 we started a work session. We discussed some questions about student learning activities in Italy and Turkey. The Criteria of student mobility selection and management procedures was discussed.



All participants received certificates for attending the 1st short term joint staff training activities in Adazi secondary school. They filled in meeting evaluation forms.



In the afternoon project participants went to the bakery “Lāči” where they had informative and educational lesson on Bakers’ Expedition. During this master-class lesson at the bakery, teachers were able to get acquainted with the baking process, saw the wood-fired clone oven and baked a loaf of bread by themselves.





This was the last place that we visited during our efficient and productive meeting in Latvia. After the tour all participants had a free time. Some of project partners departed in the evening.
