What is Culture?

- ▶ **Is a concept of various meanings, being the most current, especially in anthropology.**
- ▶ **Culture is also commonly associated with forms of artistic and / or technical manifestation of mankind, such as European erudite music. Definitions of "culture" were performed by Ralph Linton, Leslie White, Clifford Geertz, Franz Boas, Malinowski and other social scientists. In an in-depth study, Alfred Kroeber and Clyde Kluckhohn have found at least 167 different definitions for the term "culture." Clifford Geertz, argued negatively for the gigantic amount of culture definitions, considering a development of great value to develop a concept that was coherent internally and had a definite argument.**



8 Multiple Intelligences

- ▶ **35 years ago, Howard Gardner wrote Theory of Multiple Intelligences, explaining their implications for educational processes and personal development. According to Gardner, each individual has eight types of intelligence that together collaborate in the formation of his personality, influencing the strengths and weaknesses of each. Thus, a person may have greater ease with some actions or content than with others. Through the Theory, Gardner raises the following question: does the educational system really meet the needs of each child or end up being flawed, since it is generalist while each has its own facilities and difficulties?**

➤ **Visual- Spatial**

It is the ability to understand figures and constructions only by looking, without needing formulas. It is quite developed in architects, engineers.

➤ **Verbal-Linguistic**

High ability to learn languages, master words, write and speak accurately. Present in writers, poets, journalists.

➤ **Interpersonal**

It is linked to the ease that a person has in dealing with others. Religious, teachers and political leaders have such high intelligence.

➤ **Musical-Rhythmic**

It is linked to the sensitivity to notes and timbres, and the ability to create new music and musical patterns. It is, for example, in singers and composers.

➤ **Bodily-Kinesthetic**

It is the ability to use one's own body to produce something or even solve problems. Present in athletes, dancers and actors.

➤ **Intrapersonal**

Related to the ability to solve problems and to know and understand oneself. Present in psychotherapists and writers.

➤ **Logical-Mathematical**

Ability to use formulas and create logical reasoning, interpreting symbols. Quite developed in mathematicians and scientists.

➤ **Naturalist**

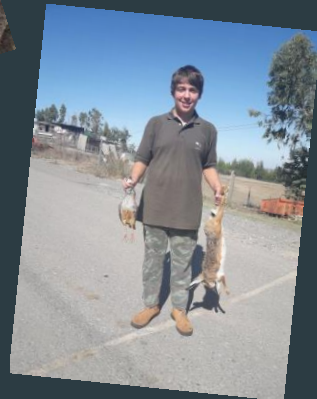
It is quite high in biologists and geologists, for example - it is the sensitivity of analyzing nature around them, classifying plants, animals.
