Lesson Plan

Subject: <u>sport</u>	Grade: <u>8 (14-yr-olds)</u>
Topic: <u>across country borders</u>	
Learning Standards: <u>Listening & speaking / watching</u>	
Objectives: <u>International sports / differences</u>	
Materials: <u>wb / computer</u>	
Time: <u>40 mins</u>	

1) Engage

Ask:

what are the most popular sports in your country?

whats your favourite sport?
(Ss reveal their own ideas)

(write on wb and compare)

How often do you do sports? (discuss) ^{elicit ideas}
which sports would you like to try? (from different countries)

2) Explore

Make lists from researching on internet in class quickly. (First elicit them compare)

Discuss which sports are most popular
Look at any differences.

Ask: what each sports person needs to do the sport?

3) Explain

Brainstorm - why we do sports?

why its necessary to do sports?

How sports keep us and our life clean and
have them no time to participate in bad habits.
what positive things SPORT brings to our lives

4) Elaborate

Show videos/present before and after
ideas of doing sport how it can improve
you/your health and what the difference
makes to them

Body wise / Eating / Lessons / Sleeping / Attitude

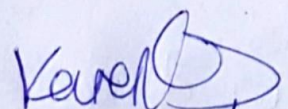


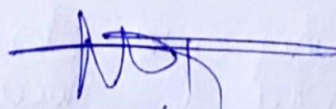
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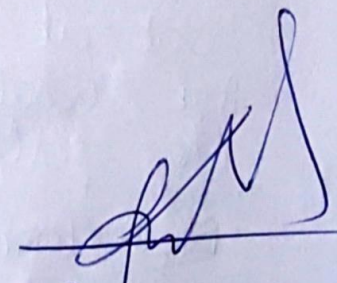
5) Evaluate Ataturk said " Healthy Brain
