

LESSON PLAN: 1st year – 10th Lesson/Sep'18

TITLE	The teapot that became flower pot (Hans Christian Andersen)   
THEME	Art/Technology
GRADES	6 th Grades

DURATION	90'(2X45 minutes approximately/per month)

OBJECTIVES	<p>Through the lesson, pupils will be able:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To realize that teapot inspired all forms of Art, over the years. 2. To exercise their listening abilities in the English language. 3. To exercise their reading abilities in English. 4. To comprehend a fairy tale written in English, by answering questions based on its content putting them down on their note pads. 5. To draw and color the fairy tale on their drawing papers. 6. To complete an electronic puzzle depicting a teapot, on the interactive board.
DESCRIPTION	<p>Pupils will be shown a fairy tale in the English language, entitled “The Teapot” by Hans Christian Andersen on the interactive board while simultaneously will be listening to its narration. Afterwards a pupil will repeat and narrate the same fairy tale in Greek. Finally, pupils will have to answer comprehension questions based on the fairy tale, in their note pads. Afterwards, they will be asked about the answers they gave and their different perspectives. There will be a transformation of their answers in real life (parents and children). The fairy tale will be given to them in Greek, so they will be asked to draw and color it, depicting the fairy tale on their drawing papers. Then they will solve an electronic puzzle on the interactive board.</p>

EVALUATION	<p>At the end of this two-hour lesson, pupils should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Realize that Art has been inspired by the teapot over the years.• Fairy tales have included teapot and become very successful.• Fairy tales depict the real life and formulate the positive attitudes in it.• Listening to the English fairy tale, understand, comprehend, narrate and write down their notes, improving their English use of language.• Electronically depict a teapot on the interactive board.
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
