In the afternoon there was a guided tour of the city’s monuments and in the evening dinner at a local tavern.



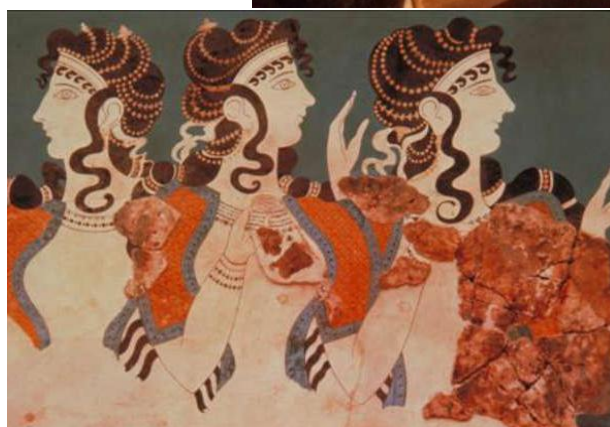
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Day 2- Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> May
