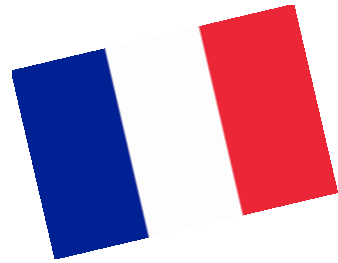

Montpellier was founded in 737 after the merger of two villages and was then called Mons pessulanus or Pessulus. In the 11th century, it developed thanks to trade with the East and became an important milestone on the pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela. In 1141 it obtained city rights.
