

# THE AMPHITHEATER OF ARLES

The Amphitheatre of Arles is a Roman historical building, built at the end of the first century A.C. It is the largest amphitheatre of Gaul as well as the oldest plaza de toros where bullfighting is still taking place.

The name of Arles is linked to the painter Vincent Van Gogh who stayed there in 1888-1889 making about three hundred paintings.
