In order to assess the quality of the Short Exchange of Students held in CEIP de Cervo school, Spain, during 21st-27th October 2018, a questionnaire was offered to the host families participating in the Short Exchange (a copy of the questionnaire is available in the Twinspace)

The aim is to evaluate the Short Exchange and the activities done, as well as the organization, the planning and the quality of the activities developed and its relevance to the Project.

The results are communicated and shared with partners to ensure future improvements and/or changes.

15 families answered this questionnaire.

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All questions in the questionnaire from **1 to 12** were to be evaluated choosing a punctuation among five choices which were: **strongly disagree, disagree, neither agree nor disagree, agree, and strongly agree.**

Questions 13 and 14 ask for opinions or comments.

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**Question 1: I am aware of the importance that an Erasmus Project has got in a school.**

11 families marked 'strongly agree' and 4 families marked 'agree'.

Just 1 family wrote a comment for this question:

- *It is very enriching.*

**Question 2: I can identify all the countries involved in the Project.**

12 families marked 'strongly agree' and 3 families marked 'agree'.

No comments were written for this question.

**Question 3: The Erasmus corner is in a visible place at school.**

10 families answered 'strongly agree', 4 families answered 'agree' and 1 family answered 'neither agree nor disagree'.

No comments were written for this question.

**Question 4: The information I've been given about the Project is enough for me to understand it.**

12 families answered 'strongly agree' and 3 families answered 'agree'

No comments were written for this question.



**Question 5:** I've been invited to a meeting in which I was given information concerning the Short Exchange of Students, the activities planned and the timing.

13 families answered 'strongly agree' and 2 families answered 'agree'

No comments were written for this question.

**Question 6:** The information I've been given by the Erasmus coordinator and/or the school was sufficient to understand what to expect from a hosting process within a Short Exchange of Students.

12 families answered 'strongly agree' and 3 families answered 'agree'

No comments were written for this question.

**Question 7:** On the occasion of the hosting, in our family we felt motivated to know and have more information about the country of origin of the person we hosted.

11 families answered 'strongly agree' and 4 families answered 'agree'.

No comments were written for this question.

**Question 8:** Our family felt more connected to the school, to other families and to other countries thanks to the Erasmus Project.

13 families answered 'strongly agree' and 2 families answered 'agree'.

No comments were written for this question.

**Question 9:** As a family we felt supported by the school and the Project's coordinator during the hosting process and they answered to our doubts and worries.

11 families answered 'strongly agree' and 4 families answered 'agree'.

No comments were written for this question.

**Question 10:** Our overall view of the country of origin of the person we hosted changed after this experience and now we have a richer view of his/her country.

5 families answered 'strongly agree', 3 families answered 'agree' and 7 families answered 'neither agree nor disagree'

No comments were written for this question.

**Question 11:** We, as a family, consider that an experience involving hosting students from other countries and different cultures helps to improve critical thinking and intercultural consciousness.



12 families answered 'strongly agree' and 3 families answered 'agree'.

Just 1 family wrote a comment for this question:

- *This kind of experiences are directly proportional. Good both for the hosting family and the host student.*

**Question 12: We, as a family, are ready to repeat this experience and to recommend it to other families.**

10 families answered 'strongly agree' and 5 families answered 'agree'

Just 1 family wrote a comment for this question:

- Without a doubt, I'll repeat the experience.

None of the **questions from 1 to 12** were marked with: **disagree** or **strongly disagree**.

**Question 13: What aspects will you improve regarding the organization of both the hosting process and the activities done during the Short Exchange?**

8 different families answered this questions and they wrote the following:

- *It would be better to have more time, one week is not enough.*
- *Nothing, everything was perfect.*
- *Fort he children to be more integrated in the families, it is much better that we have a child per family.*
- *I think tat it was very well organized, maybe more days for the stay would be nice. The week ends soon.*
- *The organization was excellent, there's Little to be improved.*
- *Nothing.*
- *I would like to have a relationship with the families long beforehand.*
- *It was very Little time, when we were getting used to each other, they had to leave. It should be minimum 15 days.*

**Question 14: I think, observe, want to mention...**

- *Our family would host more students. We loved this experience of hosting families.*
- *This Project is very beautiful and it is the best thing that can happen to both student that travel and the ones that host during the Exchanges.*
- *It was a wonderful experience. As a host family we lived very rewarding moments.*



- *In my opinión, this kind of experiences should last longer (at least 15 days), because the children start to get the most of the experience during the last days of it.*
- *We never thought that, as a family, hosting a girl will bring us that much. It was a wonderful experience.*
- *For us this was our first experience of this type, very positive to the whole family and eager to do it again in the future. We are aware of the difficulties concerning the organization of something like this with many countries at the same time. So we say thank you to the teaching staff for giving us the chance of having this experience.*
- *The monitoring before hosting was motivational, with advice and suggestion for it to work. The activities done during the hosting were varied and enriching. The experience for the family, and specially my kids, was very positive, encouraging language and cultural Exchange.*

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This questionnaire reflects families' opinions and feelings concerning the 2nd Short Exchange of Students. Families highlight the importance of this kind of experiences for both students and hosting students/families and suggest that Exchanges of Students should last longer. Most of them define the experience as very enriching and would recommend it to other families though some of them suggested a long beforehand contact with the student's family.

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
