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In order to assess the quality of the Short Eschange of Students held in CEIP de Cervo school, Spain, during 21st-27th October 2018, a questionnaire was offered to the students (both local and hosted) participating in the Short Exchange (a copy of the questionnaire is available in the Twinspace)

The aim is to evaluate the Short Exchange and the activities done, as well as the organization, the planning and the quality of the activities developed and its relevance to the Project.

The results are communicated and shared with partners to ensure future improvements and/or changes.

43 students answered this questionnaire.

Question 1 was a general evaluation concerning the Short Exchange of Students. Here, students evaluated:

- Communication with the families previous to the meeting.
- Meeting places at school.
- Guidance from the coordinator, help and availability.
- Communication with the families during the Exchange.
- Quality of materials used during the Exchange.
- Opportunities to bring suggestions, opinions and discussion.
- Duration and timing of the activities.
- Atmosphere of the Exchange.

These items were evaluated choosing a punctuation among five choices which were: **poor, satisfactory, Good, very Good,** and **excellent.**

The vast majority of students' answers punctuated all the items with **Good**, **very Good** and **excellent** (these last two were the ones chosen by most of them.) Just two items were marked as satisfactory by two different students in each case.

None of the items were marked with poor.

Comments. 12 students wrote comments on this question:

- Surf should last longer and make the most of the time.
- Surf activity was very short.
- Surf activity was very short but instructors were great. I wish we had more time for breaks at school top lay with the new children.
- Surf should have last longer and the students should have stayed, at least, for one more week. I wish lago could stay longer, I wish they come back some day...
- I think the surf activity was very short.
- I think activities were varied. Surf was short.
- I like everything.
- I like everything very much.
- Everything is ok.
- Spanish people are very hospitable.
- Spanish people are very hospitable.
- People in Spain should learn English.



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Question 2: How important were the following activities for the success of the Short Exchange of Students?

- Welcoming at School.

- Rehearsals of the songo f the partnership.
- Working with robots and games about Fairy Tales and Creative Writing.
- Masterclass by Estíbaliz Veiga.
- Guided visit to Viveiro.
- Guided visit to the rooftops of the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela.
- Guided visit to the Galician Centre for Dramatic Art.
- Guided visit and walk aroun the historical centre of Santiago de Compostela.
- Surf and kayak activity.
- Walk around the town of Cervo and visit to Sargadelos Factory.
- Tarzan, a play in English by Face2Face.
- Traditional Magosto.

These items were evaluated choosing a punctuation among five choices which were: **not important, slightly important, important and very important.**

The vast majority of students' answers were both important or very important. Less tan 5 students punctuated the some of the activities as slightly important or not important. Ten activities out of the sixteen shown in the chart were marked with the highest rates by all students which were: Reception at the Town Hall by the Major, welcoming at school, welcoming activities (A Midsummer Night's Dream play), Rehearsals of the song of the partnership. Working with robots and games about Fairy Tales and Creative Writing, guided visit to Viveiro, guided visit to the rooftops of the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela, guided visit and walk around the historical centre of Santiago de Compostela, Tarzan (a play in English by Face2Face) and traditional Magosto.

No comments on these items.

Questions in the questionnaire from **3 to 6** were to be evaluated choosing a punctuation among five choices which were: **useless, not very useful, somewhat useful, very useful, and extremely useful**.

Questions **7**, **8**, **9** and **10** ask for opinions or comments.

Question 3: How useful did you find the Masterclass by Estíbaliz Veiga?

14 students answered 'extremely useful', 17 students answered 'very useful', 4 students answered 'somewhat useful', 3 students answered 'not very useful' and 3 students answered 'useless'.

No comments were written for this question.



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Question 4: How useful did you find the guided visit to the Galician Centre for Dramatic Art?

21 students answered 'extremely useful', 14 students answered 'very useful', 3 students answered 'somewhat useful', 3 students answered 'not very useful' and 1 students answered 'useless'.

Question 5: How useful did you find attending 'Tarzan', a play in English by Face2Face?

6 students answered 'extremely useful', 3 students answered 'very useful', 3 students answered 'somewhat useful', 0 students answered 'not very useful' and 1 student answered 'useless'.

- I recommend to other students the experience because we can know about other countries and cultures.


