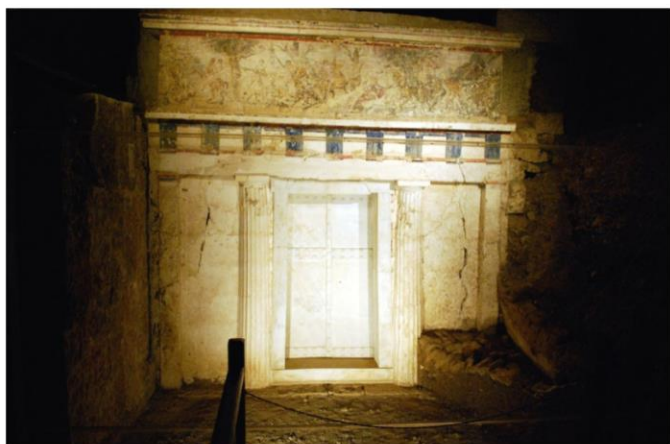

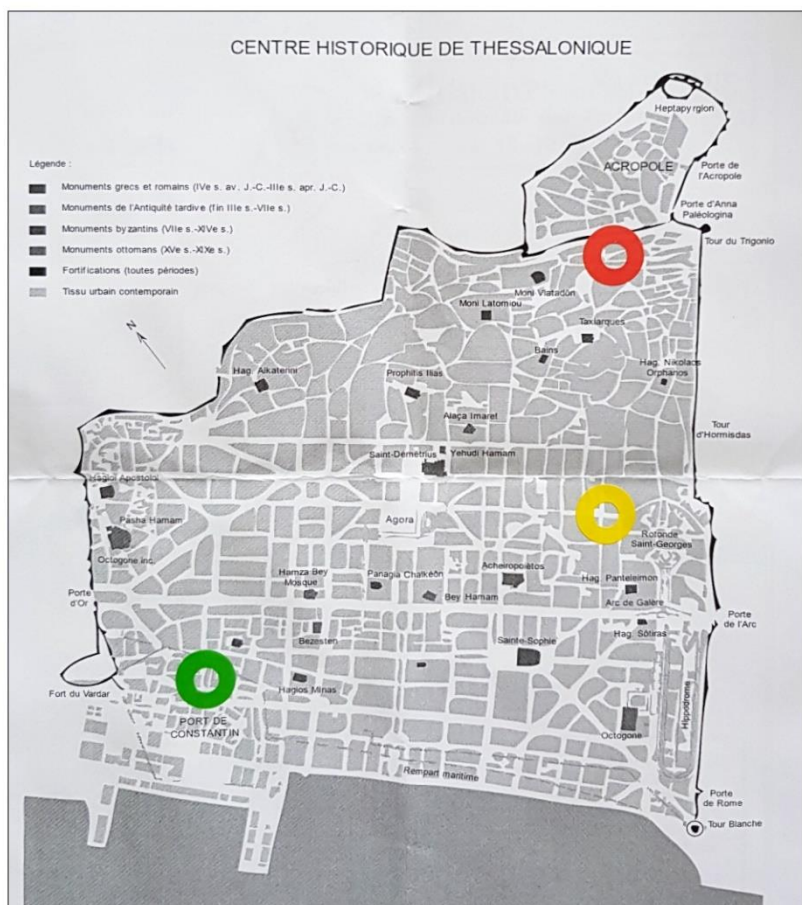
TRUE OR FALSE?

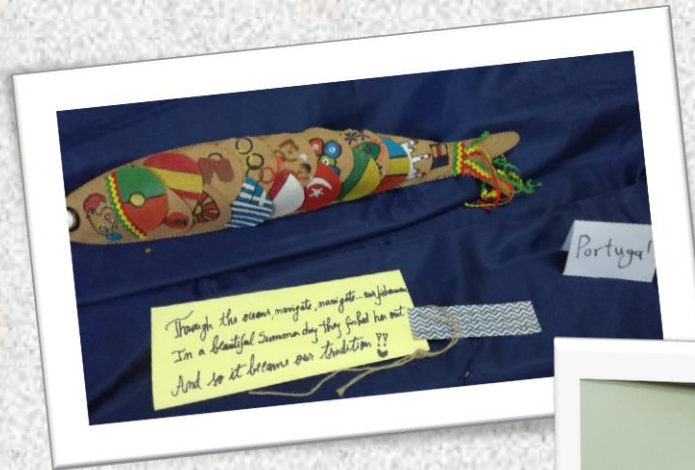
