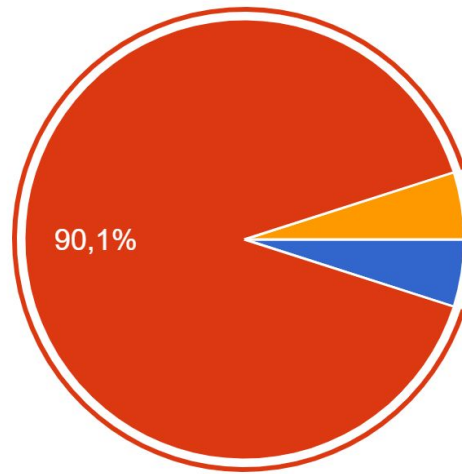

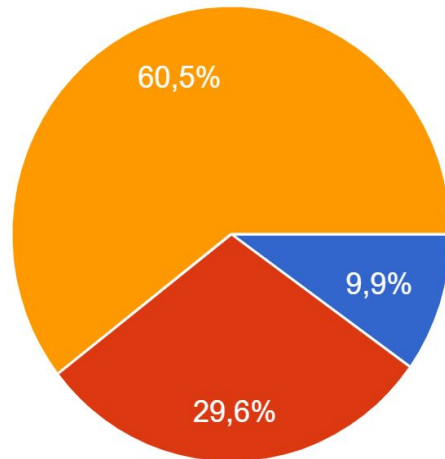

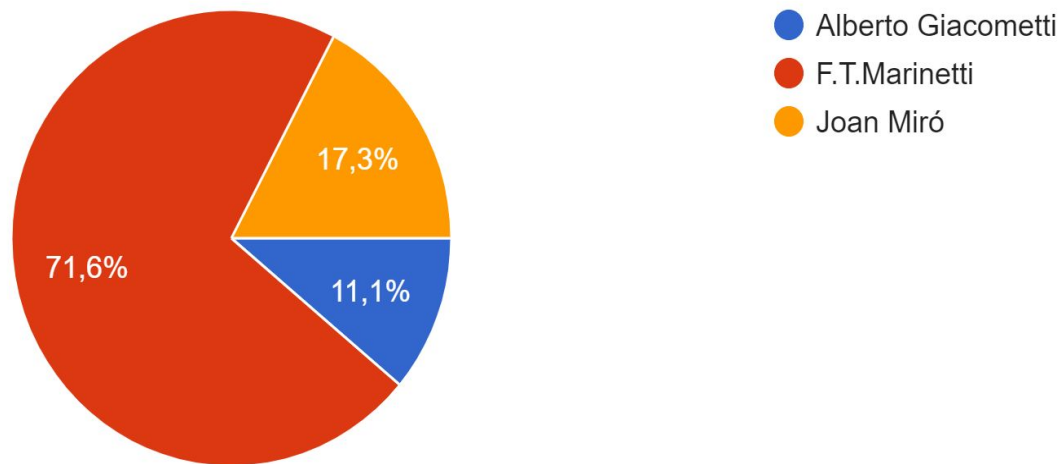

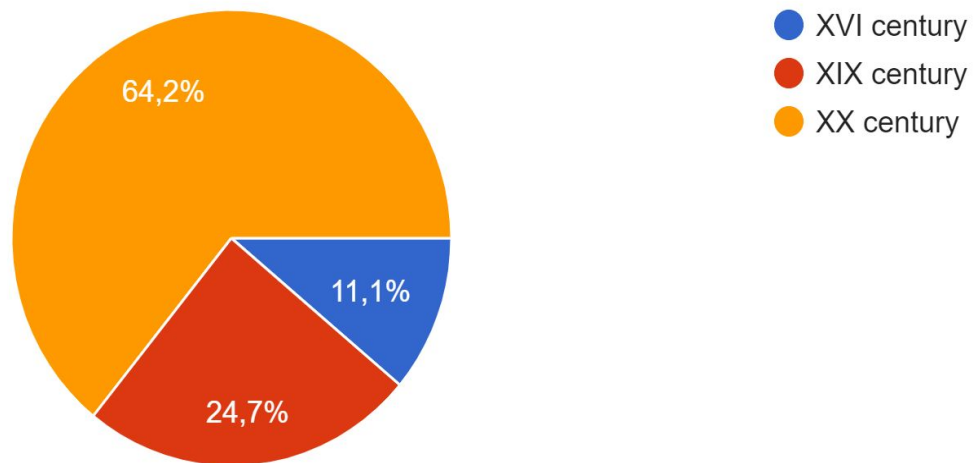

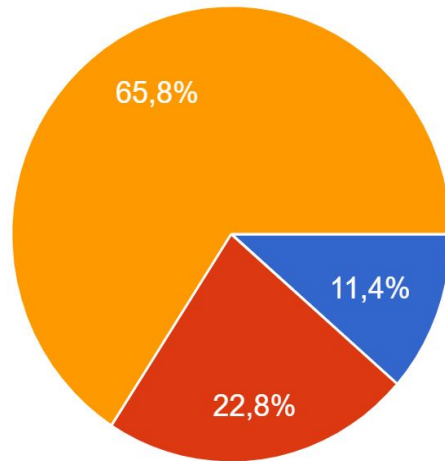

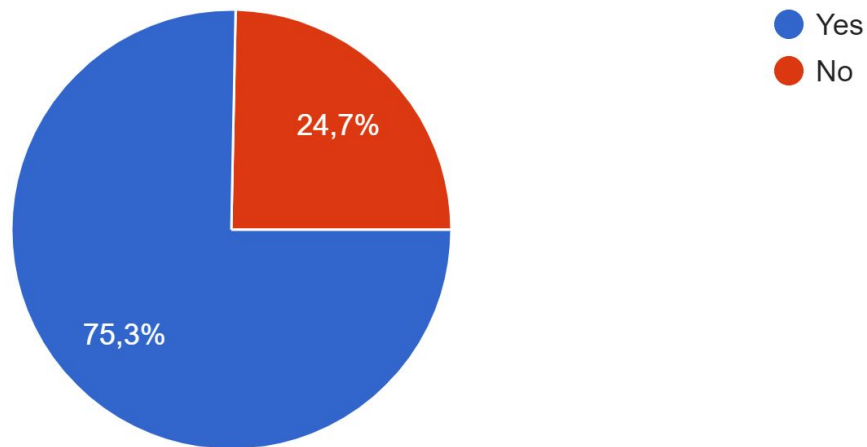


- To depict real scenes.

Because of its radical nature and the fact that it challenges existing ideas, processes and form, avant-garde artists and their artworks often go hand-in-hand with controversy and shock.

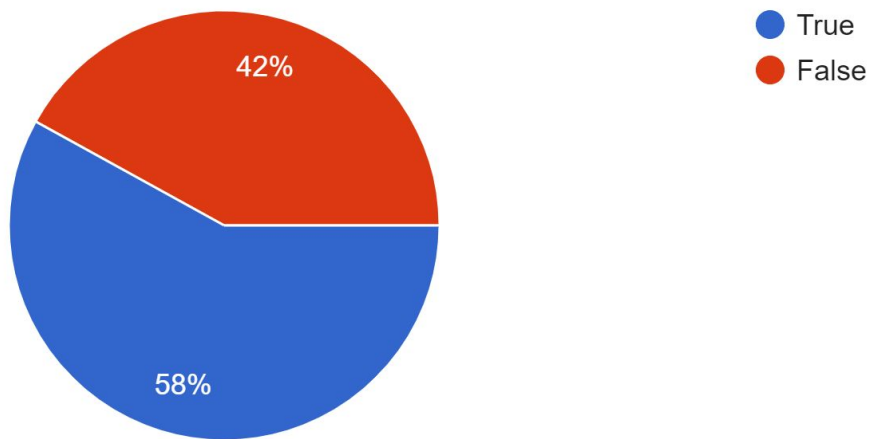

Fauvism, expressionism and cubism are the first innovative movements which opened up the path to the other subsequent innovations.

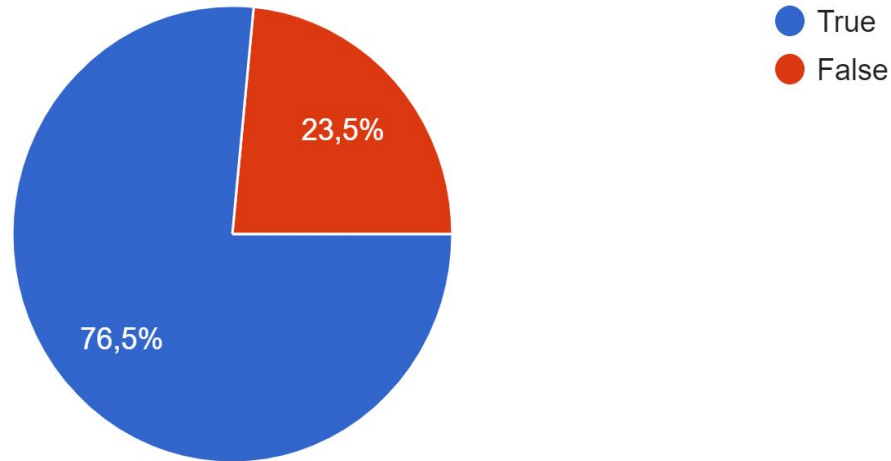

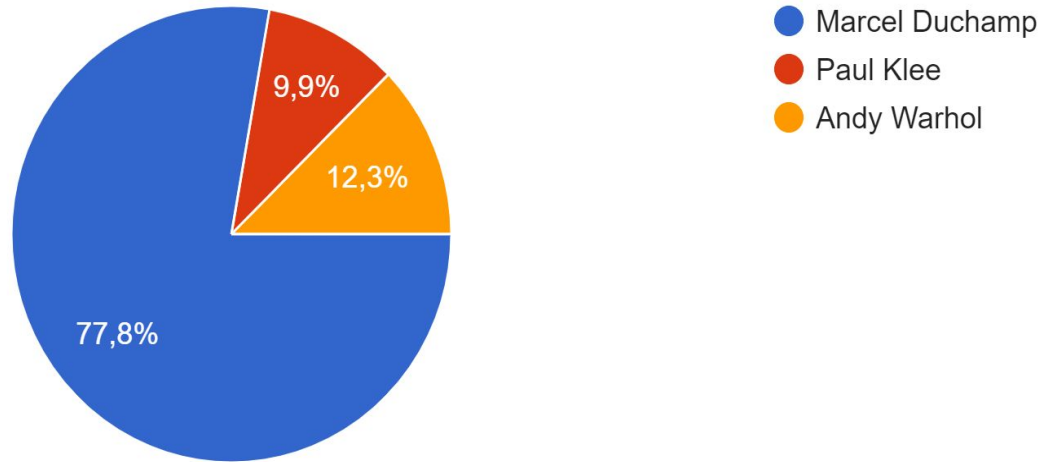

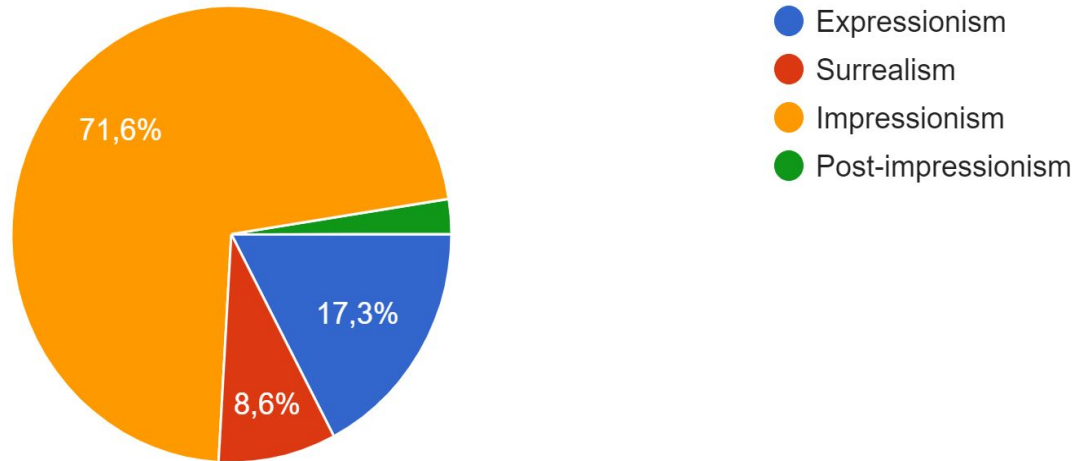

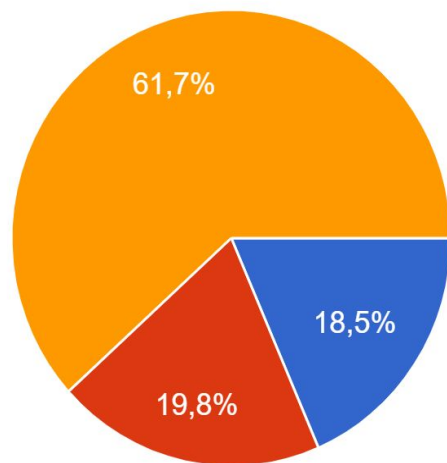

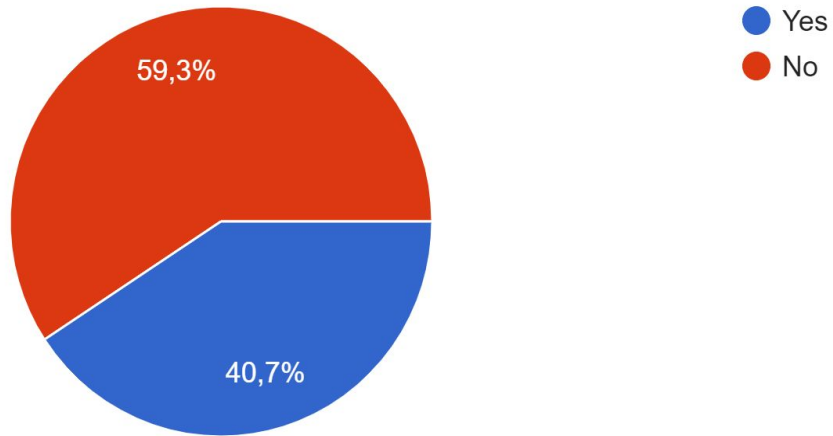

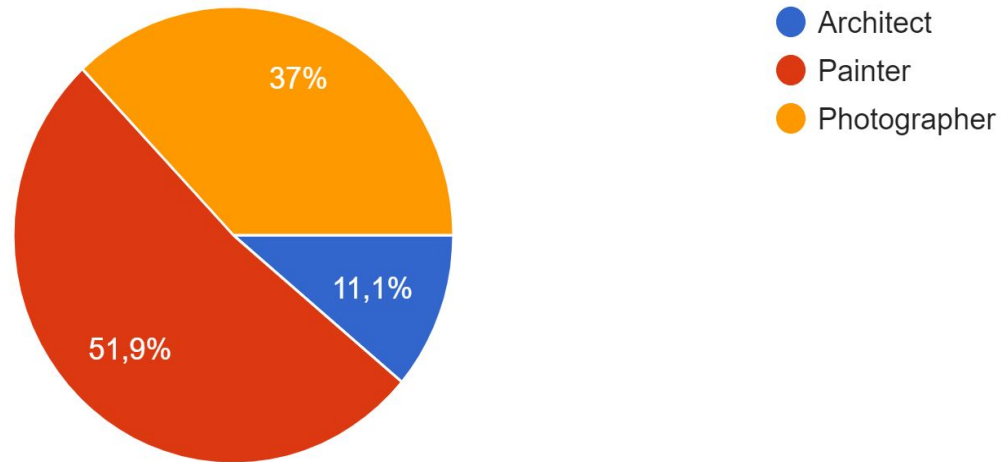

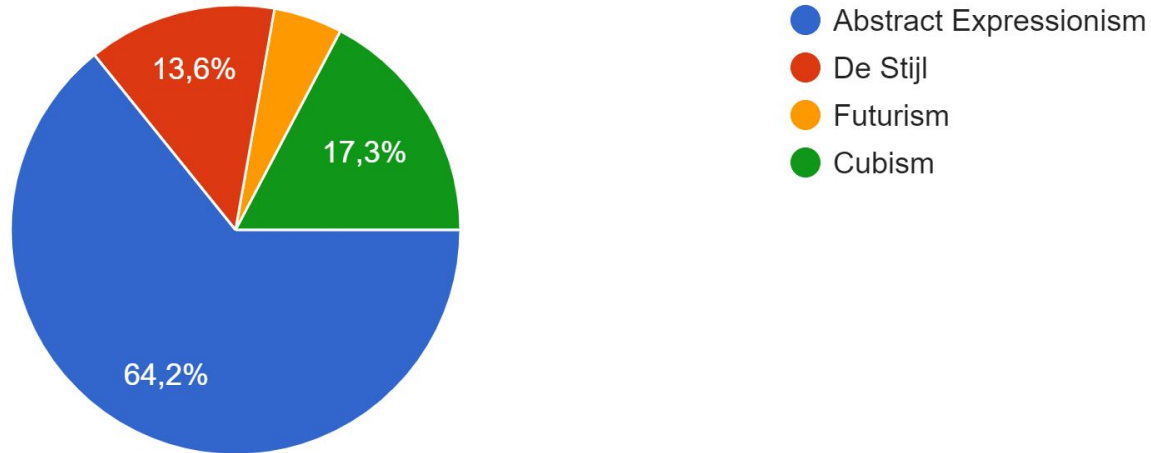

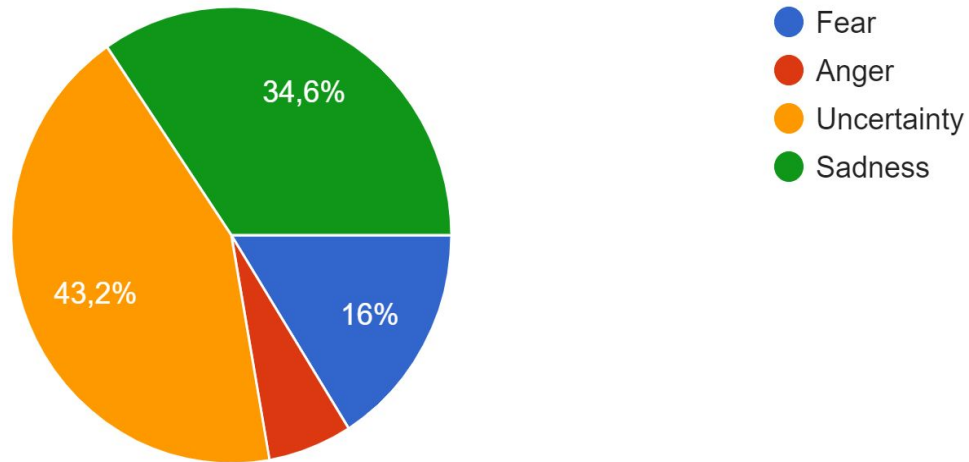

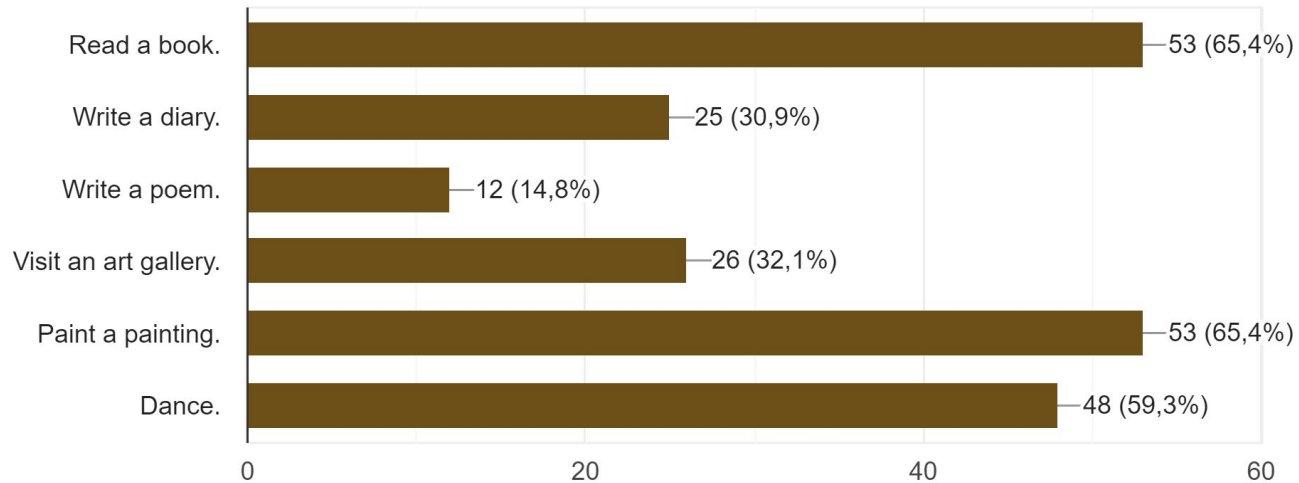
What feelings did you experience most during the worst months of the confinement?

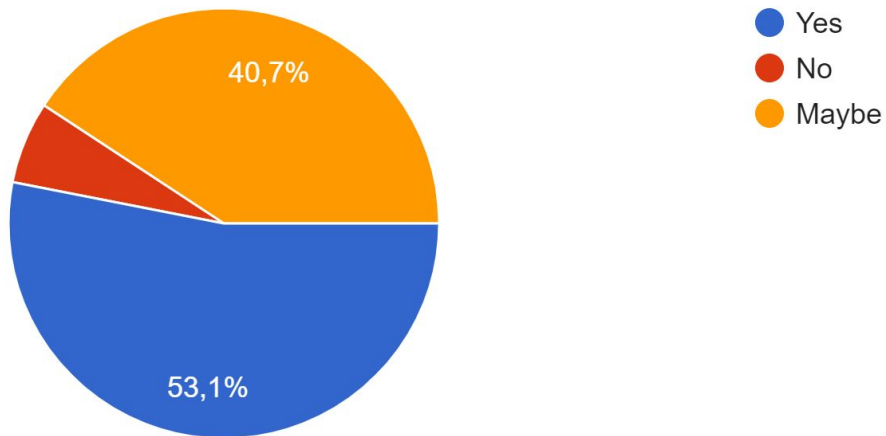
How can you express your emotions through art and get to diminish the negative impact they may exert on your state of mind? Mark the 3 options that are more effective for you.

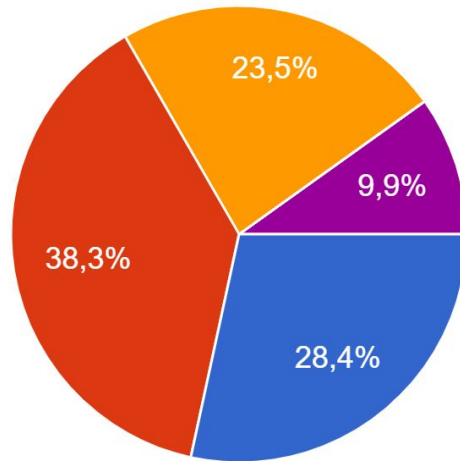
