

A Unique Erasmus+ Project Mobility Carried out in Sibiu, Romania

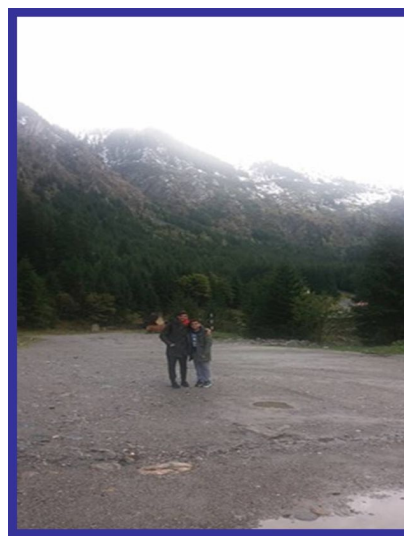
