# PAPER IS MADE FROM...

Over the centuries, paper has been made from a wide variety of materials -- wood pulp, rice, water plants, cotton, even old clothes! Today's paper fiber comes mainly from two sources -- pulpwood logs and recycled paper products.

We talked about the ecological problems:

**When you see paper and wood, what do you think of?**

**Why are Rainforests Important?**

**Can you imagine Earth without forests?**

**SO...WE DECIDE TO RECYCLE PAPER AND MAKE  
EXPERIMENT....IN OUR CLASS IN THIS WAY:**

- **Get a paper recycling bin.**
- **Separate paper from other waste**
- **Tear the paper into fine shreds and soak it in a bucket of water overnight.**
- **Use the blender or food processor to blend your paper into a fluffy pulp.**
- **Once the paper had become pulp, we transferred it back into our big tub for more mixing.**
- **Sink the mold into the water mixture. Pull the mold up, and pulp should cover the screen. At this point, you can add decorations.**
- **Use a cloth or sponge to press out excess water. Now you need to let the paper dry.**

•Tear the paper into fine shreds and soak it in a bucket of water overnight.



• **Use the blender or food processor to blend your paper into a fluffy pulp.**
