Lesson: Shapes on the surface

Key Vocabulary: Symmetry and asymmetry of flat characters

Educational goals:

- to observe, to explore, to express and evaluate the application of the shapes on the surface in symmetrical and asymmetric compositions
- to define and describe free shapes
- to distinguish proper and symmetrical characters, irregular and asymmetrical characters
- to express themselves in the technique of collage of regular and irregular characters in a symmetrical or asymmetric composition

Socialization and educational objectives

- to develop awareness of the value of their own opinion and of the need to respect others' opinions
- to promote a sense of beauty and discover aesthetic values in visual arts
- to encourage autonomy and cooperation

Motif: visual; geometric shapes and other figures

Topic/Art task : Easter eggs

Art Technique: Painting - Paper Collage

Materials: paper collage , aluminum foil, scissors, glue

Procedure:

Space and accessories for work will be prepared with students. They will be given half of the styrofoam eggs that should first be painted with the basic colour which they choose.

I will demonstrate to the students cutting shapes from the paper surface. The shapes are flat or two-dimensional shapes. They can be regular and irregular, geometric and free-form or organic shapes.

Symmetrical shapes can be obtained by folding and cutting of paper one-half of the desired character. When the paper is dissolved it will get a symmetric shape.

Students will get free shapes by scraping paper or aluminium foil which are asymmetric because they cannot

be divided into two equal parts. They will also get directions to choose a few colours of collages or aluminium foil. The collage or foil is torn to make free shapes.

Then students will combine and glue them on the surface of the styrofoam eggs. The layout of the shapes and colours is chosen at their own discretion.

Later, students will glue the two halves of decorated styrofoam eggs and put ribbon on it.

At the end of the lesson the students evaluate, compare and comment on the work they have done.
