(5 min) Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will talk about Edmodo. The teacher will check if the teachers from partners' countries use it in their schools. What do they use it for? Today we are going to introduce Edmodo and its features and do a brief check on our project 	Conversation and teacher – directed method
(35 min) Main part	<p>Activity 1 – Edmodo – introduction (10 minutes)</p> <p>The students will use presentation to introduce Edmodo. They will explain its basic features and the basic tools contained in its interface.</p> <p>Activity 2 – Edmodo – creating the account (10 minutes)</p> <p>Once participants are introduced about the interface and features of Edmodo, the ones who do not have an account create it and log in to Edmodo. Participants who already have an account join the ERASMUS group so everyone can complete the following task.</p> <p>Activity 3 – Edmodo - practice (10 minutes)</p> <p>Using Edmodo, we will share materials about our project in the ERASMUS group. The materials contain basic concepts that most participants are familiar with without studying the materials</p> <p>TASK: All participants take a quiz to check their knowledge about the project. We explain to them the type of questions provided by Edmodo and how to solve a specific type of question. Please note that Edmodo is case sensitive. For this reason, all the answers to the missing word should be capitalized as it is set out in the solution.</p> <p>Activity 4 – Results - demonstration(10 minutes)</p> <p>The results of the quiz will be presented with an explanation of the statistical views provided by Edmodo.</p>	<p>Conversation and demonstration</p> <p>Teacher – directed method and individual work</p> <p>Individual work</p>
(5 min) Conclusion	In the end the teacher and the students will talk to participants about Edmodo to find out if they can see the possibility of applying Edmodo in their teaching.	Conversation and teacher – directed method
