MAMMALS



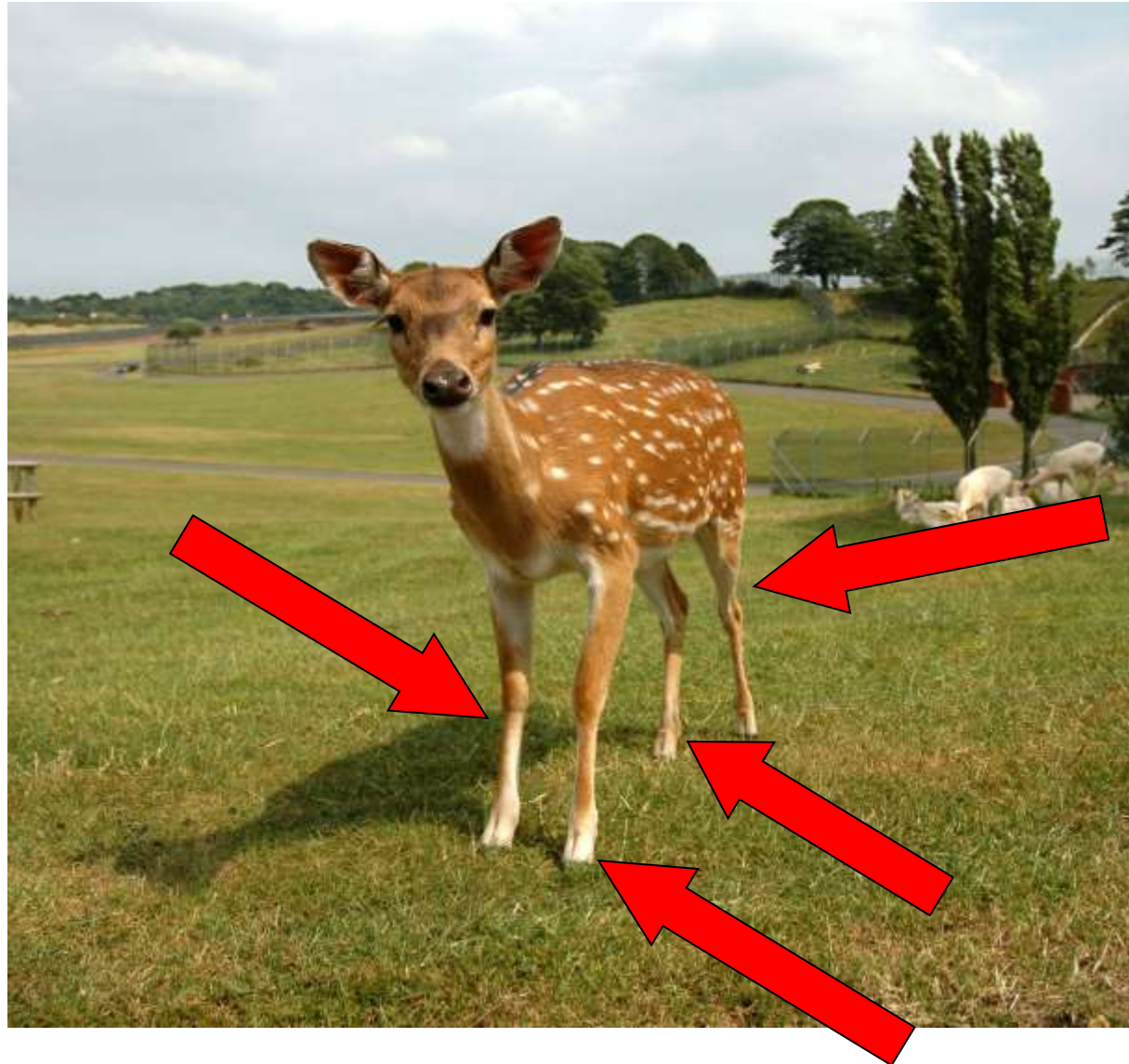
- have hair or fur

- warm-blooded



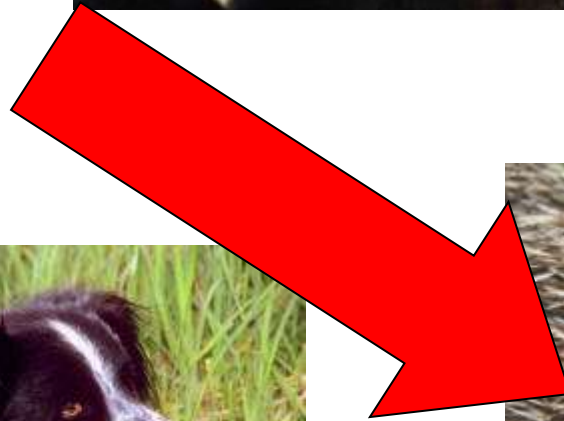
Mammals have four legs.



Baby mammals are born **live.**



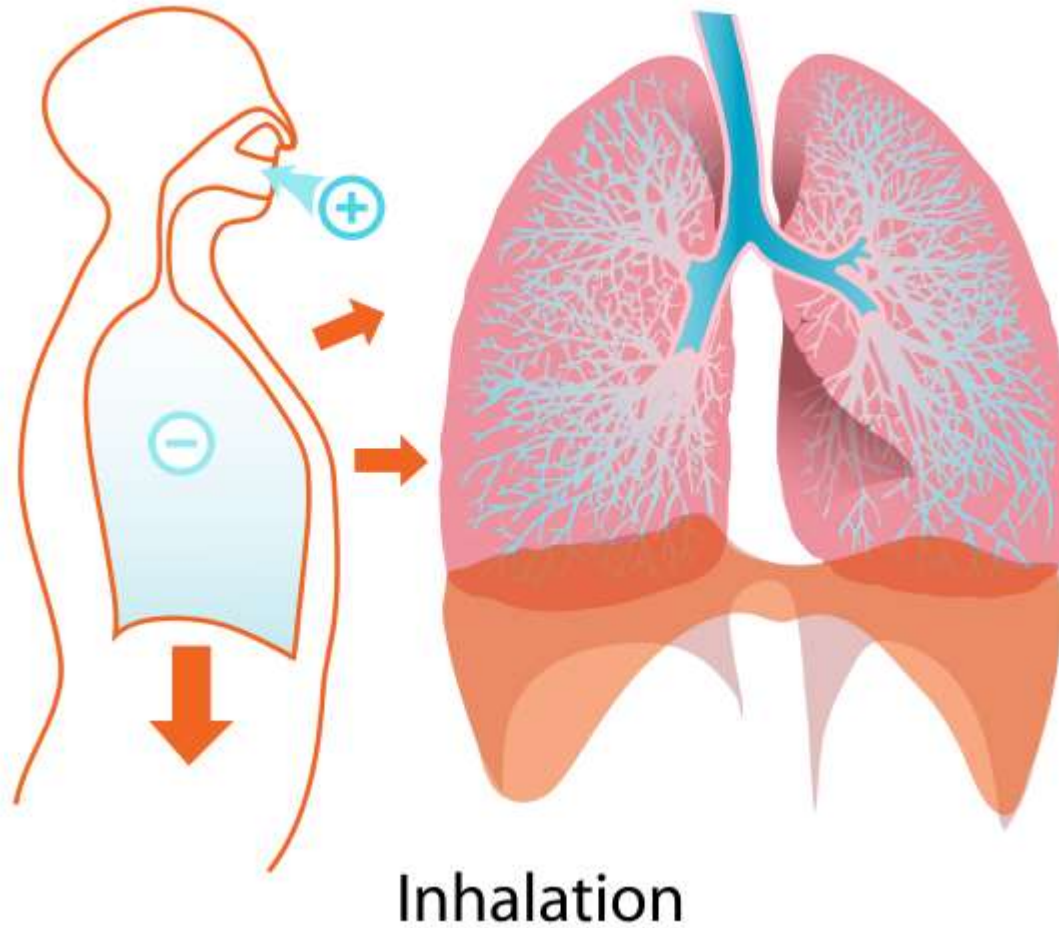
