#### Information about our trip to Flúðir.

**Accommodation:** We have rented two houses side by side. Each house has four bedrooms (two rooms with twin beds and two rooms with bunks). Both houses have an outside hot tubs.

**Food:** We will cook our dinner (both nights) in a team (some have to cook or prepare or clean after dinner). We will have 1. lamb and 2. salmon, of course some sweets and wine. Lunch will be at restaurants 1. Laugarvatn and 2. Flúðir. At breakfast we will have oatmeal and toast. If you prefer something else you can buy it at the store in Flúðir. Please let us know if you have <u>food allergies.</u>

**Cleaning:** We have to clean the houses when we leave, that is no problem we are so many it will be max 20 minutes.

**What to bring**. Good shoes for walking, warm clothes for outdoor activities best if it holds back rain, swimsuits, towel (maybe two for the country) and positive attitude that is 100% needed for the trip. **Expenses**. Iceland will pay for the rental cars and gasoline also part of our food.

<u>Each person has to pay 150 Euros</u> for the days in the country (accommodation, food, swimming). We will make an invoice for each country inform us what name should be on the invoice.

**IMPORTANT**: there is not so much space in the car for luggage so please pack a <u>light bag</u> with you to take with you to the country (two nights). We will keep your luggage in the school or the hotel. "Less is more"

  - · Swimming downtown Reykjavík in Sundhöllin which is the oldest public pool in Iceland
