



ACTIVITIES TO DEVELOP THE EMOTIONS FRAMEWORK
TÍTLE: stick figures à la Paul Klee
SCHOOL: Borsigwalder Grundschule
OBJETIVES/AIMS: painting large scales, getting to know Paul Klee, concentration on feelings, expressing emotions with art, human proportions
PARTICIPANTS: grade 5/6
TIMING (date of realization): 2019
RESOURCES: paper, watercolour
DESCRIPTION OF THE LESSON/ACTIVITY: We discussed the painting “exuberance” by Paul Klee, where he illustrates an emotion by only painting a stick figure and underlining it with matching colors. We collected all kinds of emotions and studied the postures that we connected with them. Each pair of students chose one emotion and drew it on a big scale. Then they colored the background to underline their emotion.
EVALUATION CRITERIA: creativity, clean painting, identification of the painted emotion
EVALUATION: (Proposals for improvement , agreements, tasks) It helped to physically imitate the postures that you connect with an emotion. Also, the task should be done in a team (pair), so the students have to discuss their steps.
