

ACTIVITIES TO DEVELOP THE EMOTIONS FRAMEWORK
TITLE: Vincent van Goghs sunflowers
SCHOOL: Borsigwalder Grundschule
OBJECTIVES/AIMS: getting to know Vincent van Gogh, painting large scales, painting what you feel, not what you see
PARTICIPANTS: grade 4
TIMING (date of realization): 2020
RESOURCES: paper, pencil, watercolor
DESCRIPTION OF THE LESSON/ACTIVITY: We discussed the painting “sunflowers” by Vincent van Gogh. We set up several vases with big sunflowers in the room and the students first drew them with a pencil, then colored them with watercolor. They were encouraged to paint the bouquet how they personally see them, and not to paint them accurately.
EVALUATION CRITERIA: creativity
EVALUATION: (Proposals for improvement , agreements, tasks) Since the pupils worked on their paintings for several weeks, it makes sense to use plastic flowers as models. Also, this unit makes sense in autumn, when sunflowers can be discussed in other subjects, too.
