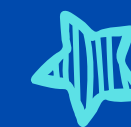

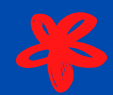



# Challenges for Students with Special Needs



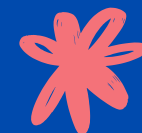
LESS ONE-ON-ONE ATTENTION
