INTRODUCTION - TRAILER



'WONDER' IS THE FILM ADAPTATION OF THE NOVEL OF THE SAME TITLE BY R.J. PALACIO. IT IS DIRECTED BY STEPHEN CHBOSKY AND WAS RELEASED ON NOVEMBER 17, 2017. IT STARS JULIA ROBERTS, OWEN WILSON AND JACOB TREMBLAY. IT TELLS THE STORY OF AUGUST PULLMAN, AUGGIE, FOR SHORT (JACOB TREMBLAY). HE WAS BORN WITH TREACHER COLLINS SYNDROME. TREACHER COLLINS SYNDROME IS A CONDITION THAT AFFECTS THE DEVELOPMENT OF BONES AND OTHER TISSUES OF THE FACE. THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF THIS DISORDER VARY GREATLY, RANGING FROM ALMOST UNNOTICEABLE TO SEVERE. MOST AFFECTED INDIVIDUALS HAVE UNDERDEVELOPED FACIAL BONES, PARTICULARLY THE CHEEK BONES, AND A VERY SMALL JAW AND CHIN. IT WAS THIS GENETIC ABNORMALITY THAT HAS REQUIRED AUGGIE TO UNDERGO SURGERIES AND MEDICAL TREATMENTS SINCE HIS EARLIEST DAYS. THE FILM FOLLOWS A YEAR IN THE LIFE OF AUGGIE. WITH FACIAL DIFFERENCES THAT, UP UNTIL NOW, HAVE PREVENTED HIM FROM GOING TO A MAINSTREAM SCHOOL, AUGGIE PULLMAN ENTERS FIFTH GRADE AND CONFRONTS THE CHALLENGES OF ATTENDING A MAINSTREAM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FOR THE FIRST TIME. HE BECOMES THE MOST UNLIKELY OF HEROES WHEN HE DOES IT. AS HIS FAMILY (JULIA ROBERS AND OWEN WILSON), HIS NEW CLASSMATES, AND THE LARGER COMMUNITY ALL STRUGGLE TO DISCOVER THEIR COMPASSION AND ACCEPTANCE, AUGGIE'S EXTRAORDINARY JOURNEY WILL UNITE THEM AND PROVE YOU CAN'T BLEND IN WHEN YOU WERE BORN TO STAND OUT.


