


The Library of Verona has 1,200 manuscripts, 245 incunabula, 2,500 sixteenth, 2,800 six-hundred and over 70,000 volumes.





Wine Production by Region, 2020






Emilia romagna

- □ Modena has an area of 183,2 km² and a density of 261,6 hab/km².
- The cathedral of Modena, (metropolitan cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta in Cielo and San Geminiano), is the main place of worship in the city of Modena.

Typical dishes of Modena:

- TORTELLINI 478 kcal (100 g)
- Tigelle or Crescentine 301 kcal (100 g)
- Fried dumpling 345 kcal (100 g)
- Lasagna 135 kcal (100 g)
- Cotechino of Modena 301 kcal (100 g)
- Balsamic vinegar of Modena 88 kcal (100 g)



Curiosity of Modena

Modena is home to the prestigious Military Academy, which prepares cadets for the Army; hosted by the majestic Palazzo Ducale, it was built in 1634 on a project by Bartolomeo Advini, a pupil of Bernini. The Avanzini incorporated the previous and oldest castle, dating back to 1291.





The Cathedral of Modena, a Unesco World Heritage Site, was built in 1099 d.C. and is one of the most important Romanesque monuments in Italy and Europe.


Tortellini ingredients for 4 people

For pasta:
