







Story of colosseum

- The Colosseum is located in the center of Rome, it can hold between 50,000 and 87,000 people.
- It was Inserted in 1980 in the list of World Heritage Sites by UNESCO.
- The amphitheater was built in the Flavian era.
- Its construction began in 70 a.c., it was completed by Titus on April 21 in 80 AD. The building forms an ellipse.
- The current height reaches 48.5 m, but originally reached 52 m. The structure expresses the Roman architectural and construction methods of the early Imperial Age. Arches and vaults are linked together in a structural relationship. The building became a symbol of the imperial city.


