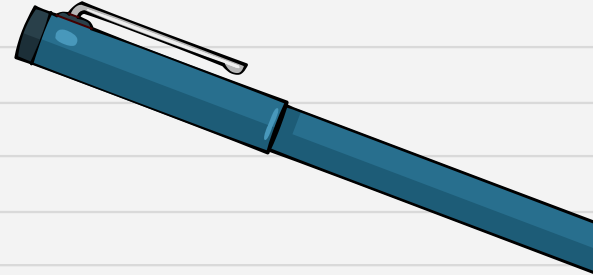
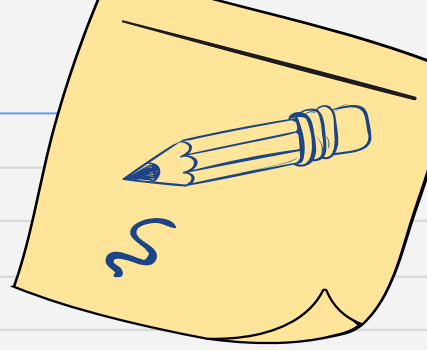
HISTORY OF TRULLI

The trulli until 1870 have not been the subject of research and study. Only from the second half of the nineteenth century did the first studies begin and the first theories, concerning their origin and construction, were formulated.



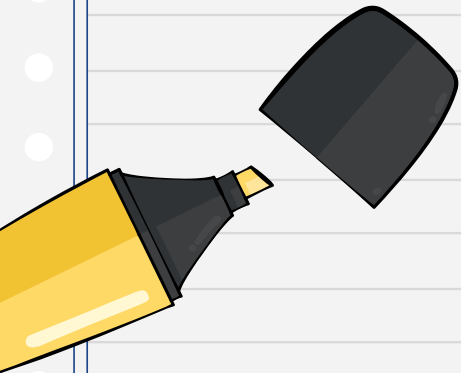
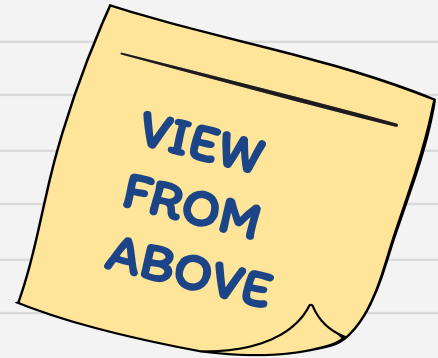
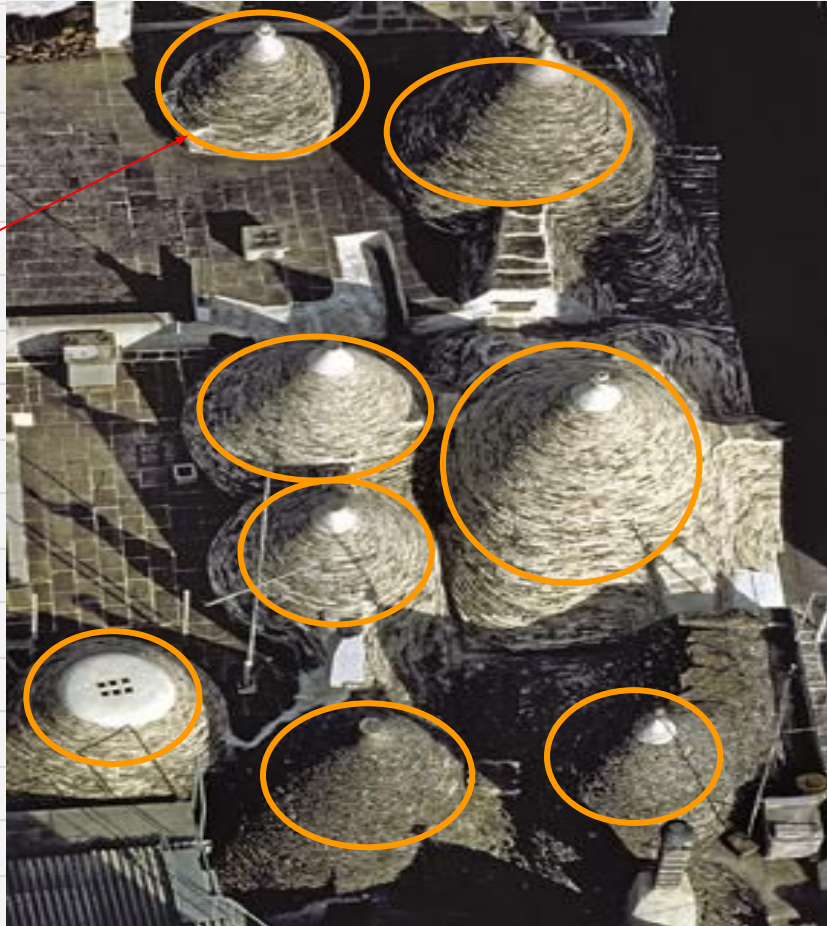
WHAT ARE THE TRULLI?

The trulli were originally peasant dwellings, where the “cozzari”, or the people who cultivate the land of the owner, could have a place to sleep and where to put the tools.

The trulli according to solid geometric figures

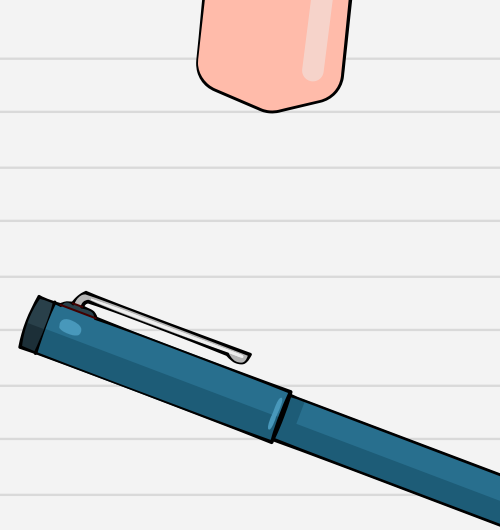


cone

The roof is covered with chiancarelle thin slabs of limestone).

It's shape is perfectly cone-shaped with an inclination of about 45 degrees; the base has a circular or square plan and only at times is the presence of a plastered drum connecting the base and the roof visible.



The typical trulli of Alberobello are mainly with a quadrangular plan and a plastered base. It's a primitive architectural typology that exploited the specific abundance of some limestone formations suitable as building material. Their origin is very ancient, the oldest trullo of which we know dates back to 1559.
