

## Report:

**Parents' survey** shows that most of the students' parents are aware of their children's participation in the Etwinning project "Good Act Epidemic". Despite having carried out the project during the curricular time not as an extra curricular activity, most of the students managed to reconcile the commitment required by the project with the study dedicated to the other subjects.

Parents noticed overall, positive changes in the behaviour of their children towards good deeds allowing the achievement of one of the main objectives of the project.

The project has improved the use of internet in security and digital competences in their sons and daughters. At the beginning of the school year students ,all coming from primary school, had very low digital competences; for this reason the results are very good and they started a process we hope to be able to improve even more in the next school year.

The project helped socialization with other foreign partners through a protected and safe platform and it helped to overcome difficulties in social relations due to this period of Covid19 which limited relationship among peers.

During the school year parents' meeting we always informed the representatives of student's parents of the project's advancements, however and unluckily it can happen that not always this information arrives to all parents.

Finally we can say that all parents are satisfied of the project and they are in favor of a future participation of the school to Etwinning projects.
