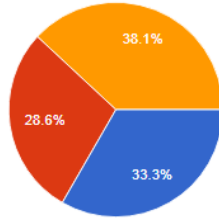

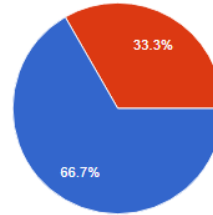

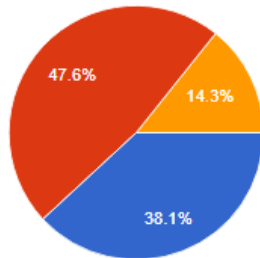

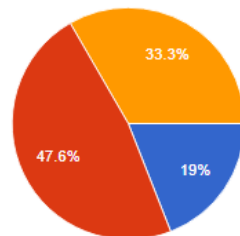

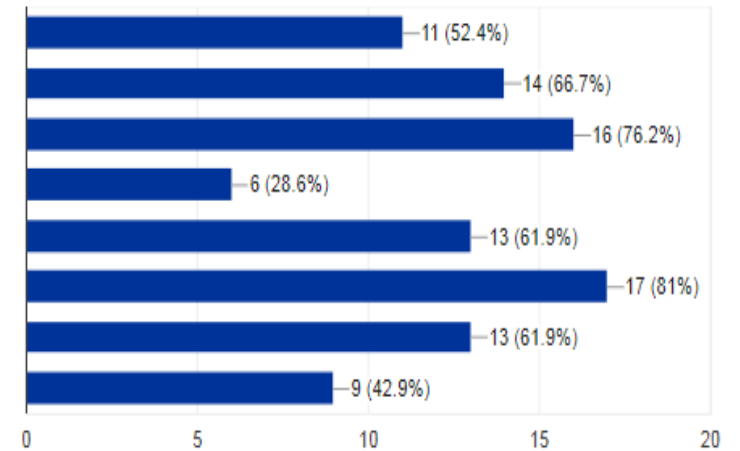

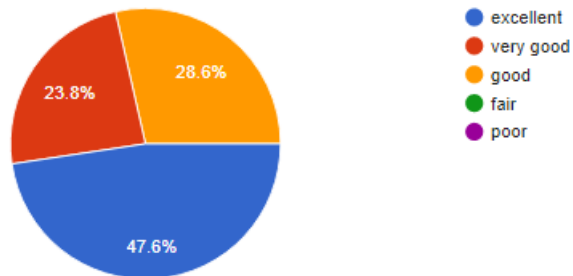

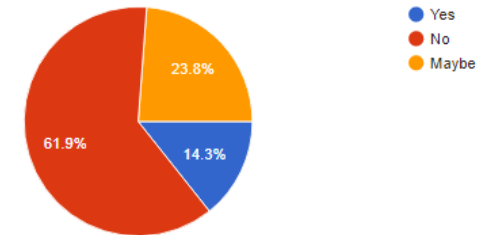

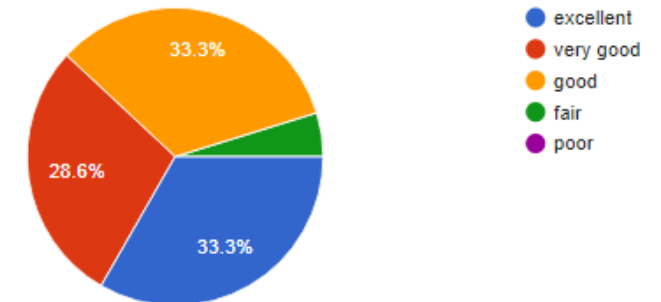
## 7 Do you think negotiating and reaching an agreement in the English language was very difficult?

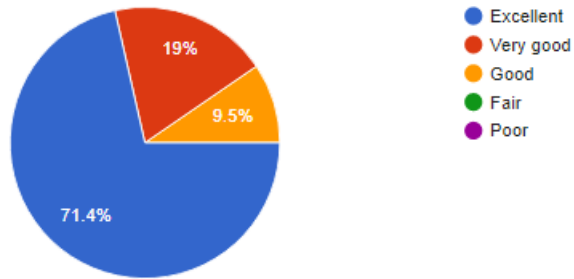

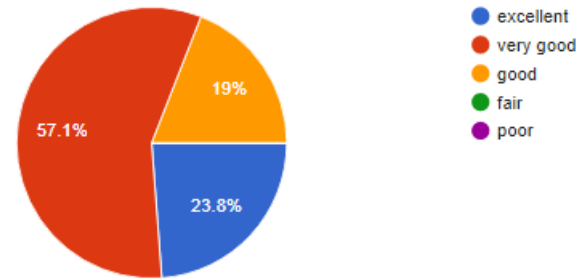

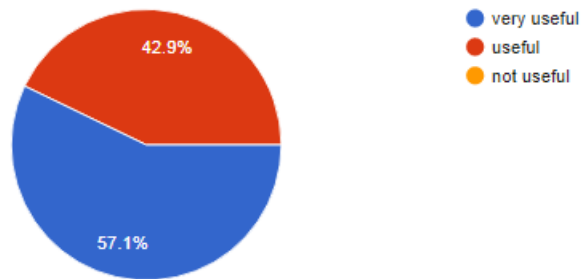

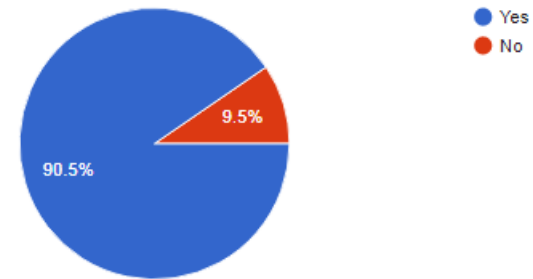
### 12 Overall, to what extent were the activities useful to you?

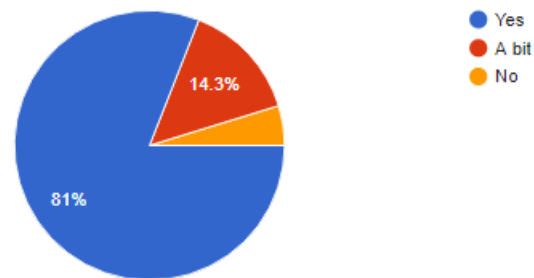
### 13 Did you feel well matched with your host student?

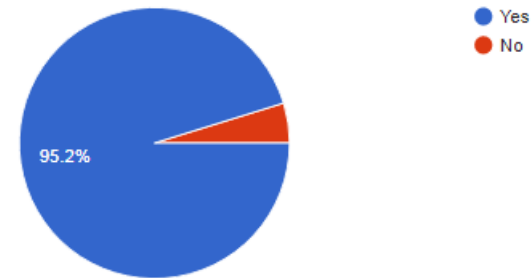
### 16 Did the participation in the learning/teaching/training activities improve your knowledge of migrations?
