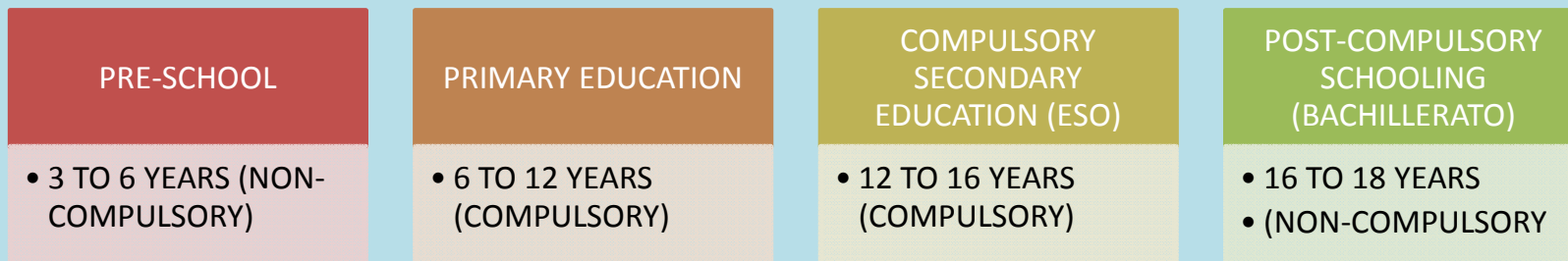

- In Spain, schooling is **compulsory** between the ages of **6** and **16** years.
- The system consists of four levels:



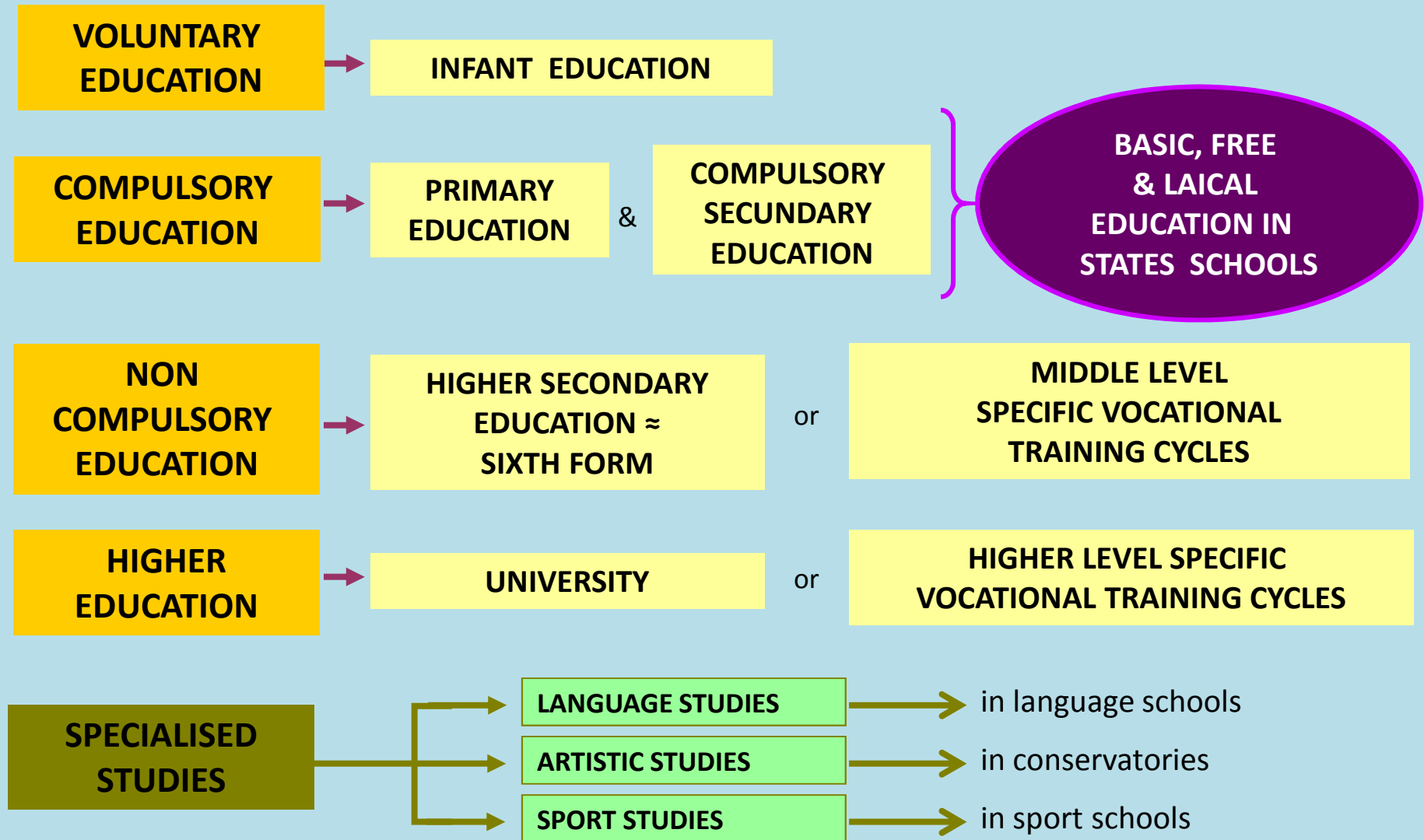
TYPES OF SCHOOLS IN SPAIN

In Spain there are public schools, laical and free, and private schools.

The schools are named:

- **Colegio** for:
 - Infant Education (*Educación Infantil*)
 - Primary Education (*Educación Primaria*)
- **Instituto**, abbreviated to **IES**, for:
 - Compulsory Secondary Education (*ESO*)
 - Higher Secondary Education ≈ Sixth Form (*Bachillerato*)
 - Specific Vocational Training (*Formación Profesional*)

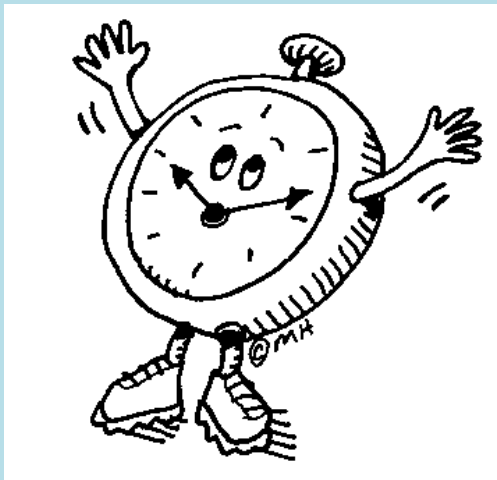

School terms

The school year is divided into THREE TERMS with a long summer holiday break of almost three months:

First term: September to December

Second term: January to Easter

Third term: After Easter to late June

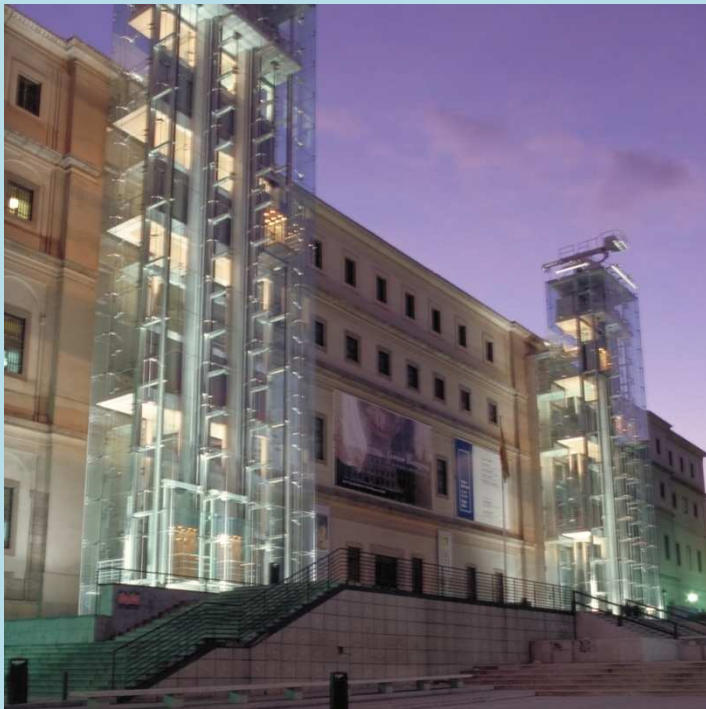

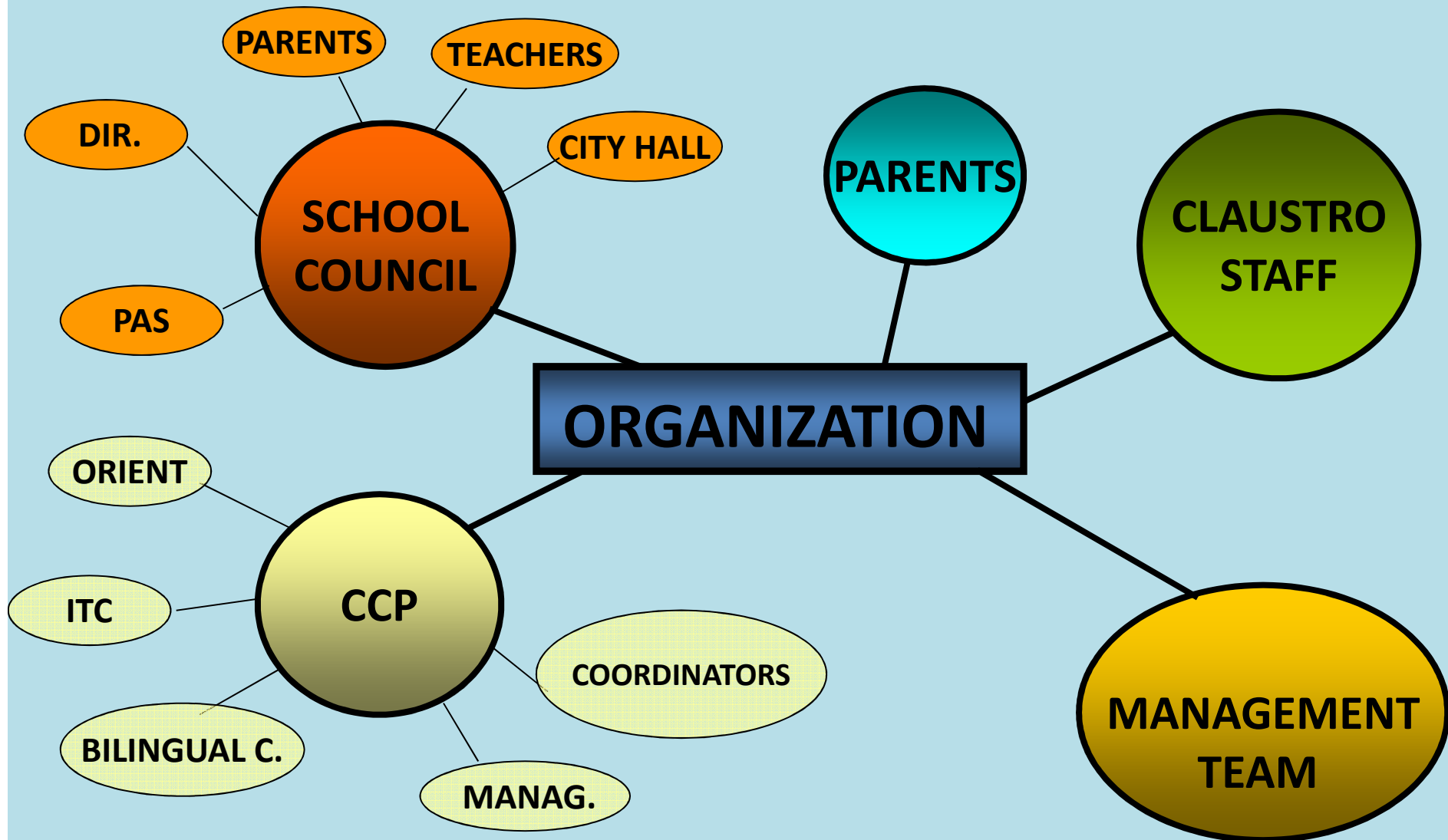
