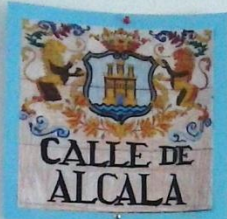

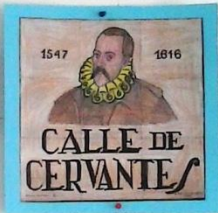
Calle de Alcala

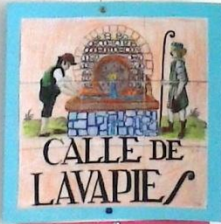
Calle de la Cava Alta

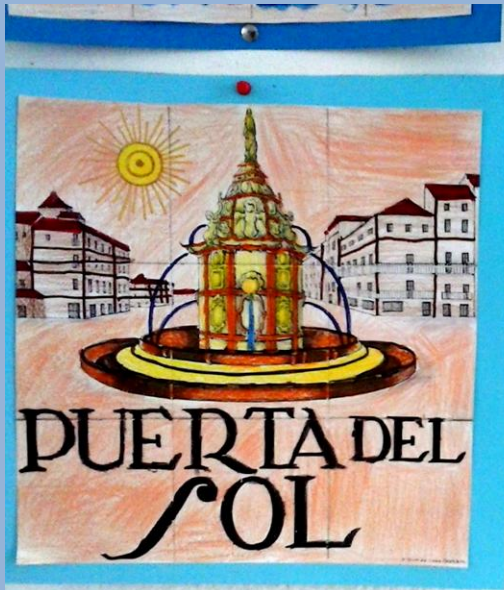

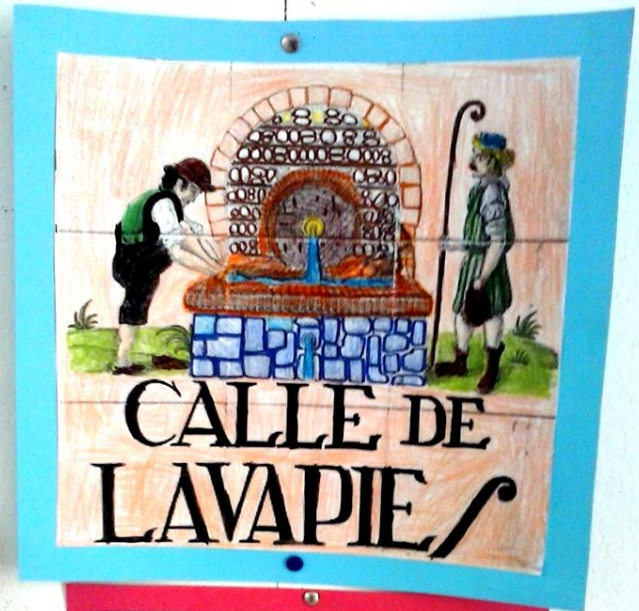

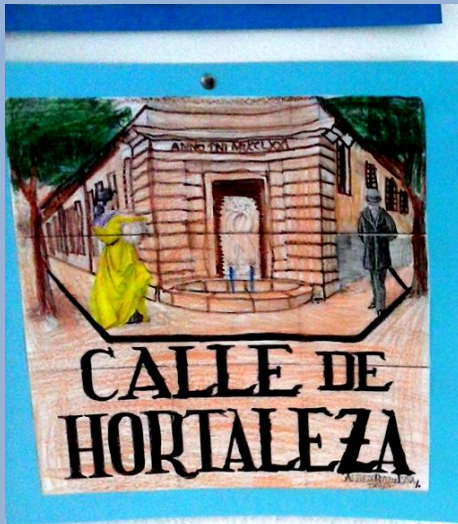
Puerta del Sol

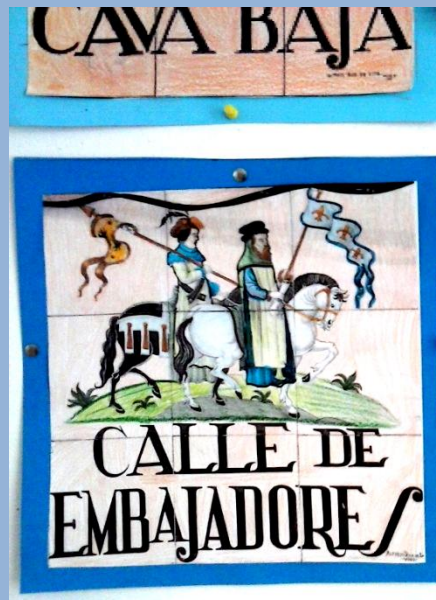
Calle de Lavapiés

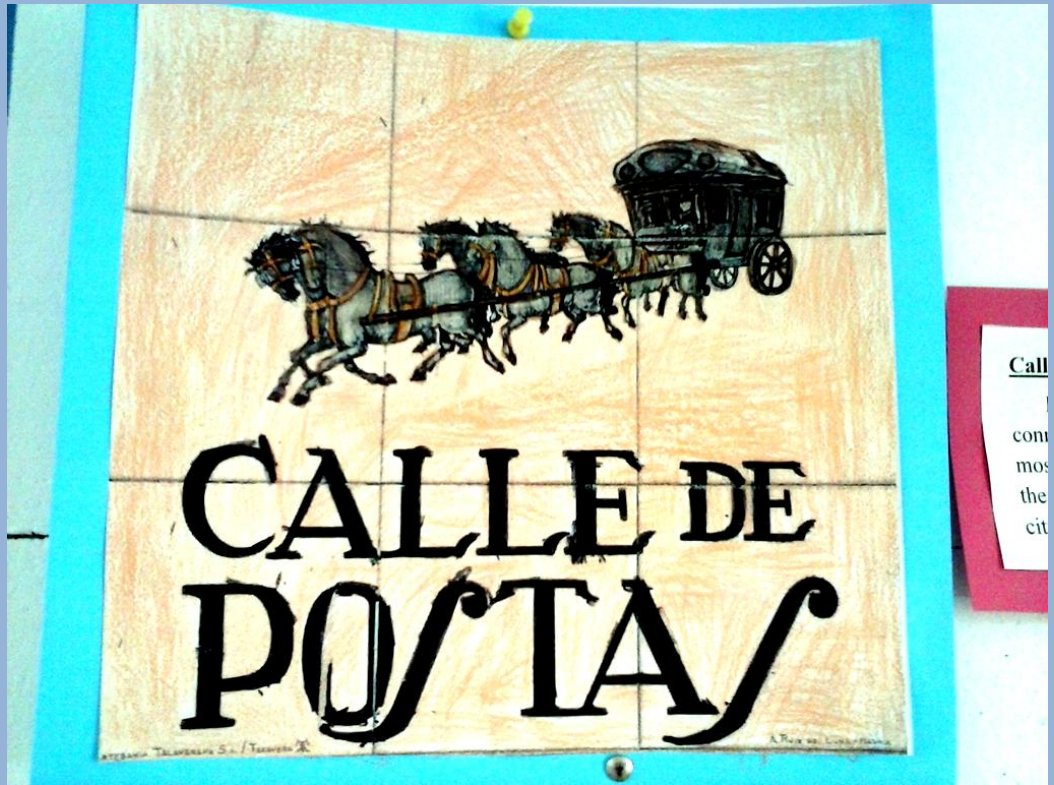
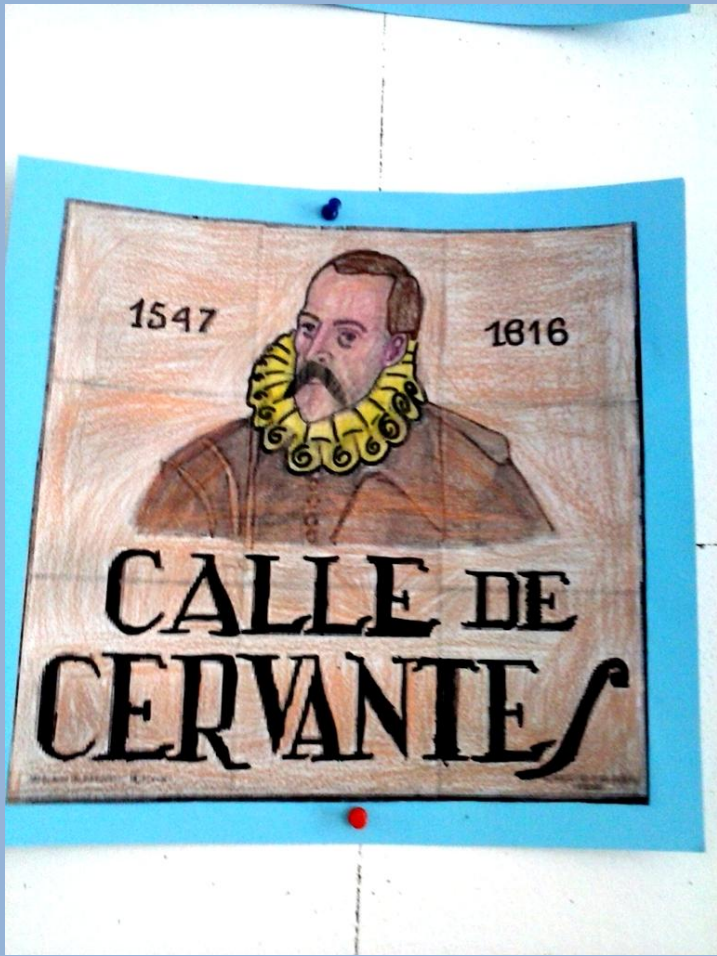
Calle de Hortaleza
