- ❧ You must pay attention to the signs and traffic lights.

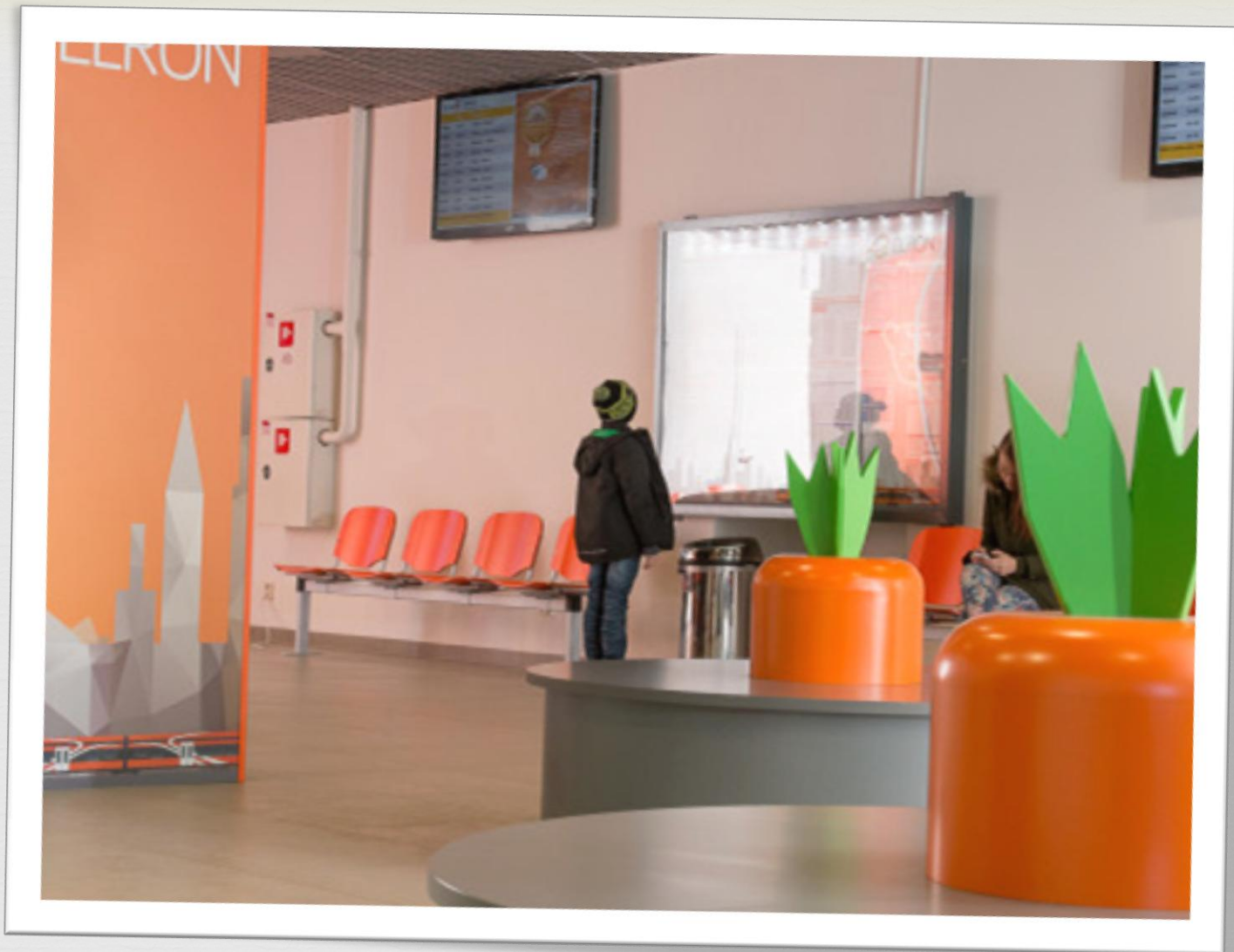

I'm going by bus ...

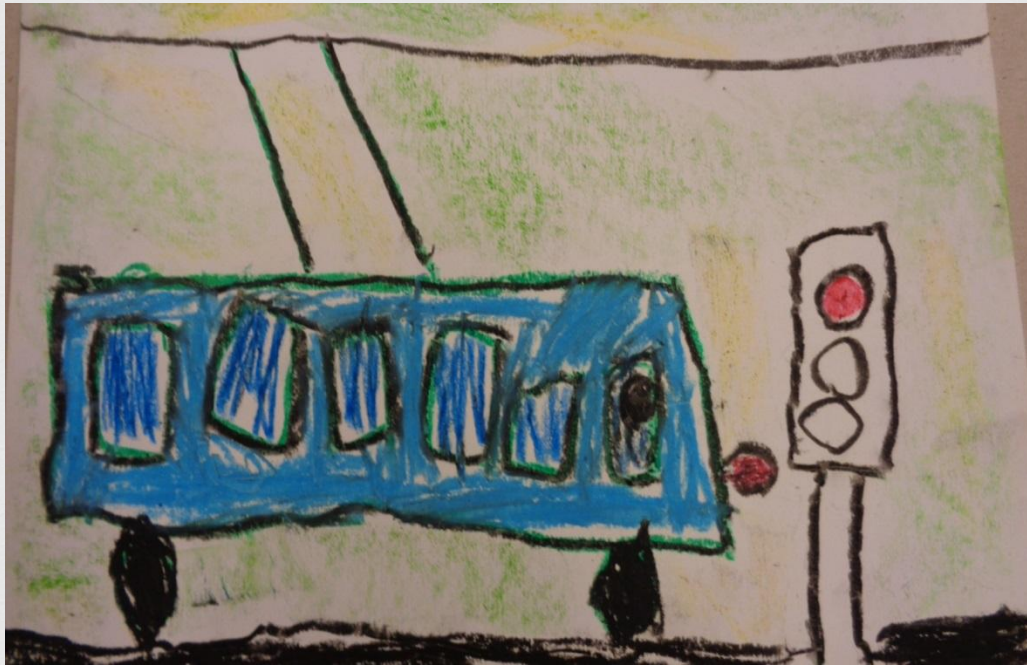


✧ Bus is a means of transport - you can ride a bus home and to the store. An ordered bus goes anywhere the person wants to go.
