Carlsberg Fredericia has about 1,500 employees, who help to produce and deliver some of the largest brands of beer, water and soft drinks as Carlsberg, Tuborg and Coca-Cola products. Carlsberg Fredericia produces 67 different kinds of beer and

soft drinks each year, like Nestea, Tuborg Christmas brew and Påskebryg, Schweppes, Sprite, Fanta mm. Corona, Sommersby, Burn energy drink, Jacobsen's beer and much more.

The headquarters are in Valby, near Copenhagen. But most of the production takes place in Fredericia. Carlsberg's CEO is a man named, Carsten Hänel.

Carlsberg brewery consists of four buildings, a brewery, beer bottling, a terminal and a soft drink terminal, which is where you can try different kinds of drinks.

Carlsberg has chosen to sponsor in sport, and Tuborg has chosen to sponsor within the world of music.

After Carlsberg in December 2008 tapped the last beer at the Carlsberg Brewery in Copenhagen and gathered their production in Fredericia, it has not been possible to see the brewhouse, fermentation tanks and bottling lines in operation. But a growing demand from the public to come in and see one of the biggest workplaces in the area, resulted in that the brewery now can be visited.

Carlsberg is working in Europe, Asia and the United States. There are several large breweries in 35 countries. These countries Carlsberg exports to. It makes it more economical and environmentally friendly, because you do not have to transport products around the world. Carlsberg also produces several different soft drinks that are popular in the individual countries, for example in Bulgaria, Carlsberg Bulgaria are producing the soft drinks Shumensko and Pirinsko .
