Who is the company owned by?

The company's name is Fynbusser, and is owned by the municipality

What kind of service are they offering?

The company offers a driving service. The way it works, is that you call the company, two hours before you have to be picked up, and then will a taxi driver come and pick you up, at the location you asked for, and drive you to your door.

What age group are they aiming for?

The age group for this service is pretty much everyone, because it is cheap, and any person, in every age can often use a cheap ride.

What is the price of the service?

The price for the service depends on how many zones you drive through, one zone cost 25 Danish kroner, and 2 zones cost 40 Danish kroner, and if you have a valid train ticket, can you drive for free.

Where is their headquarters?

They have their headquarter in Odense the biggest city on Fyn. But they also have smaller offices in other parts of Fyn.

How big is the company?

The company's name is Fynbusser, and drive busses and taxis all over Fyn, and Langeland.

All the employee is not directly employed by Fynbus, but are hired from different companys, to drive for them. The only employees Fynbus have is the it-technician, that can coordinate where the taxis have to pick up the costumers, and make sure that the itinerary is updated

where is the service offered?

You are able to order a "teletaxi" in the cities Middelfart, Assens, Kerteminde, Nordfyn, Svendborg, and Faaborg-middelfyn municipalities.
