

Naming Emotions:

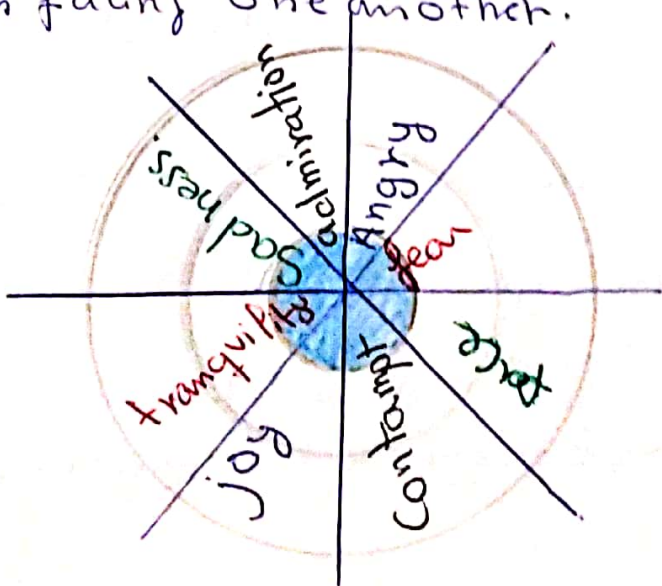
TASK 1.

* Angry \Rightarrow when I fail an exam.

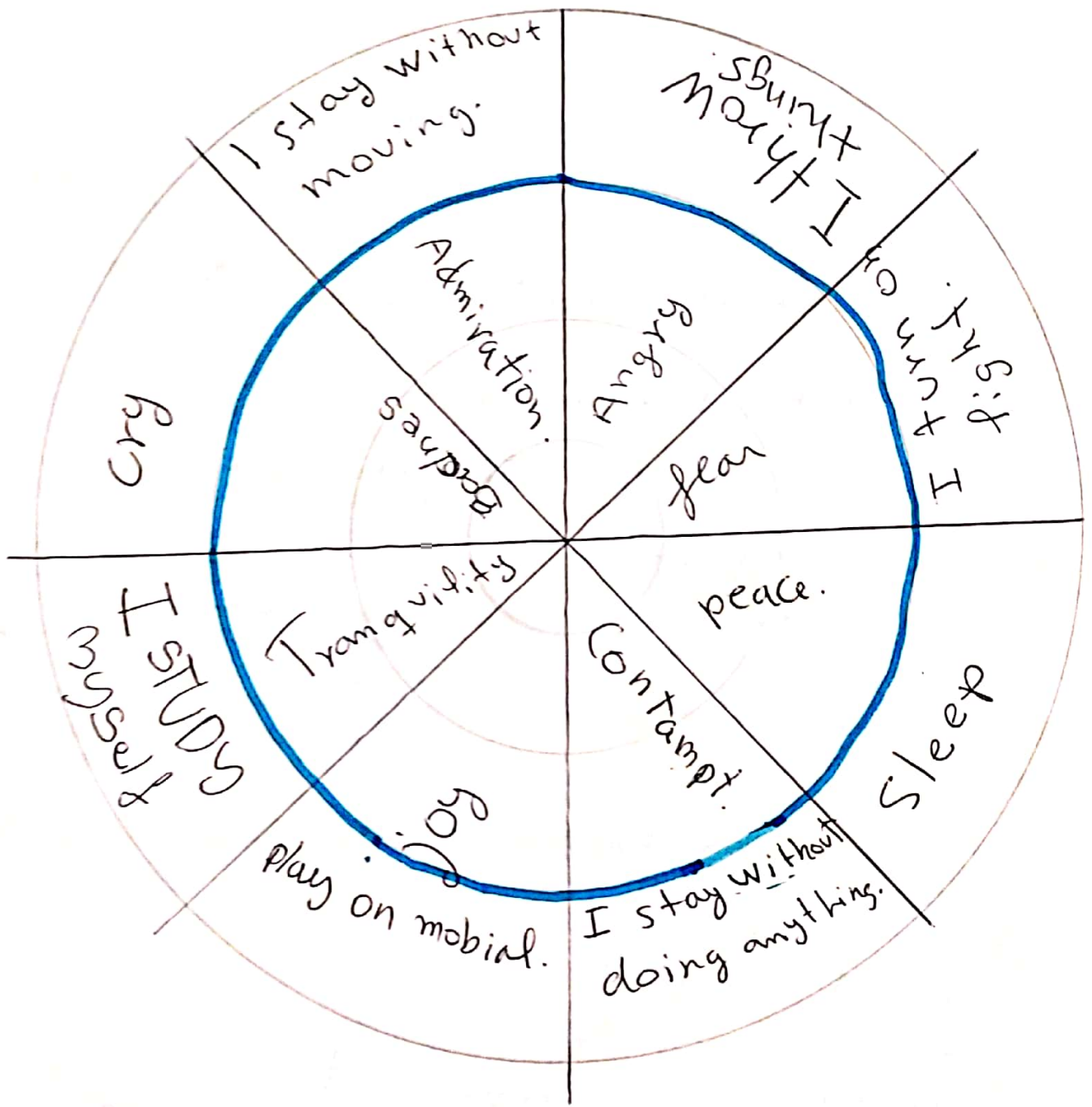
* admiration \Rightarrow when I get English 5
