
Catedral de burgos

Acueducto de Segovia



 It is the most universal symbol of the Castilian city. A great work of Roman engineering dating from the first century built with huge blocks of granite joined without mortar or mortar in an ingenious and wise balance of forces. In 1985 Unesco declared it a World Heritage Site next to the old city of Segovia.

Alhambra de Granada



 This imperishable myth, this dream palace, the most proclaimed and exalted of all time, is also an enigmatic chest of romantic and secret legends. It occupies the 16th place in the world and sixth in Europe.

Mezquita de Cordoba



 Elected the first in Europe and the fourth in the world, the Mosque of Cordoba is one of the great architectural wonders of Islamic art, declared a **World Heritage** Site by Unesco.
