Registration and logging in the

 Go to https://nearpod.com/ and click "Sign up for free" to create an account.
- On this page, students can also join your classes by entering the join code in the field – "Join a lesson - Enter code".
- Your code will be automatically generated when you finish preparing the class.

Creating classes - Lessons

- Click Create and then Lessons.
- Click Settings and change the name of your lesson.
- Click Add slide to add a slide. You can also add an existing .PNG image, .PPT presentation, .PDF document by clicking - Upload files at the bottom of the screen.
- To delete a slide, click Delete.
- To copy a slide, click Copy Paste.

Adding slides with content

- Click Video to add a video. You can add content from the Nearpod library, YouTube, your own videos stored in Nearpod, upload from your computer or cloud storage.
- Click Slide to add a slide template on which you can input your own content.
- Click Web content to add content from the internet.
- Click Nearpod 3D to add 3D movies from the Nearpod library.
- Click Simulation to add ready-made simulations useful for math, physics or chemistry lessons.
- Click VR field trip to add finished videos in virtual reality technology.

Adding slides with content ...continued

- Click BBC video to add videos made by the BBC.
- Click Sway to add an existing Microsoft Sway presentation (requires a school or private Microsoft account).
- Click Slideshow to add an existing presentation.
- Click Audio to add audio.
- Click PDF viewer to add a .PDF document To finish adding content to your presentation, click - Save & Exit.
- Enter the name of your lesson and select Grades, which is the level of teaching and Subject, which is the

Adding Activities

- Click "Time to climb" to create a quiz activity organized in the form of a ready-made competition and storyline - the first one to climb wins.
- Click "Open-ended question" to select an open-ended question.
- Click "Matching pairs" to add pairing activity.
- Click "Quiz" to prepare a quiz activity.
- Click "Flipgrid" to connect and add existing activity in the Flipgrid app.
- Click "Draw it" to add drawing ability.
- Click "Collaborate board" to share the board for collaboration.
- Click "Poll" to share the poll form.
- Click "Fill in the blanks" to prepare the fill in the gaps activity.
- Click "Memory test" to prepare the activity in the form of memory.

Starting an activity

- Click Live participation to start the live activity. In this mode, the teacher sets the pace of the displayed presentation. Live participation + Zoom means starting an activity in the Zoom videoconference program.
- Click "Student paced" to start an activity in which the student decides on the pace of the presentation. This is a mode that can work for homework.
- The system will automatically generate a code that you must pass on to your students. Students join the activity by entering the code on the Nearpod home page in the field - Join a lesson - Enter code.
- You can also share the code in the form of an email, by sharing it on social media, as a link and directly in Google Classroom or Microsoft Teams.
- The results of the conducted activity can be found in the Reports tab.
