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## **A Lesson Plan for GROWING THE SEEDS OF EUROPE**

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This is an activity that can be done in conjunction with a school garden project. We can also arrange to do this on International Earth Day.

We need plant seeds that can be cultivated in a pot.


Students research about the different plants and create QR-code labels with information for each plant.

We have multiple flower pots available as well as ribbons, fancy paper, markers and stickers to decorate them.

On the designated planting day, students are each given their own seeds and pot. Each student plants the seeds and then creates a decoration for their flower pot with the material available.

Finally nametags are placed in each pot with the names of the students and the QR-code label describing the plant.

This activity combines digital skills (internet research, QR-code generator), artful expression (flower pot decorations) and environmental awareness (planting).

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
