Reinosa forgings & Castings, known as “La Naval” is an historical steel factory for the production of special steel, in the cantabrian city of Reinosa (Spain). Inaugurated in 1987 in the public bussiness Sociedad Española of Naval Construction, and during the XX century some restructuring that culminated with the incidents of Reinosa in 1987 provoked by a massive dismissal of workers caused by the industrial reconversion. La Naval was built out of the need to rebuild the Spanish Navy after it was destroyed in the Spanish-American War. In 1930 the factory had over 2000 workers in a village of 8686 habitants.
