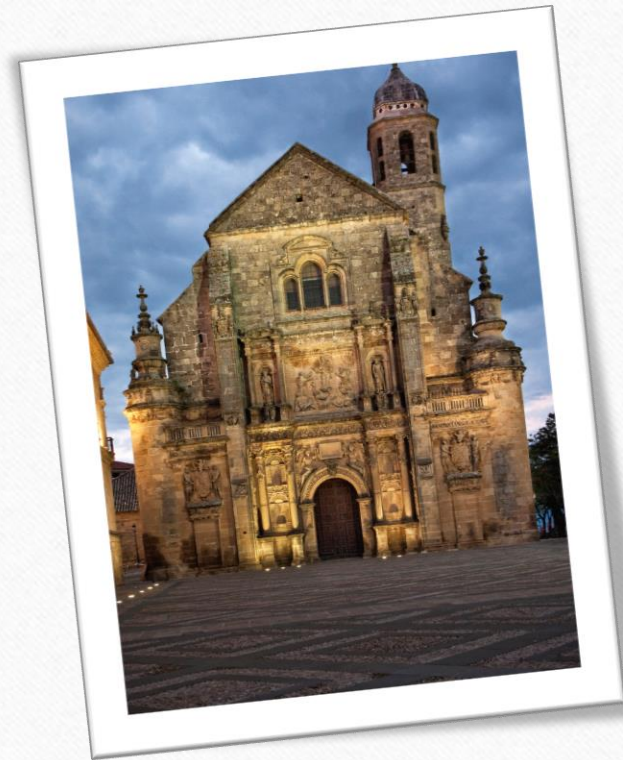

# History

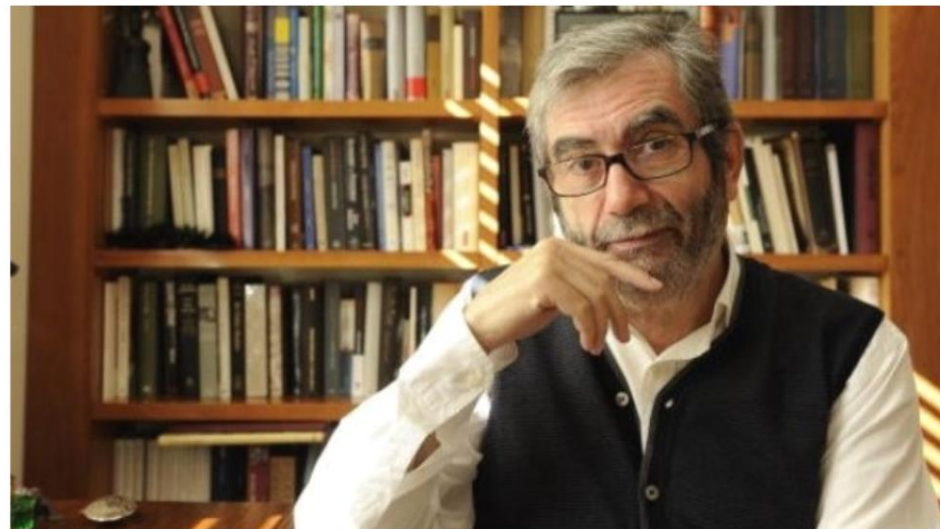


In ancient times it housed a Roman settlement, which after the fall of the Empire was occupied by the Visigoths.

# Outstanding people from Ubeda

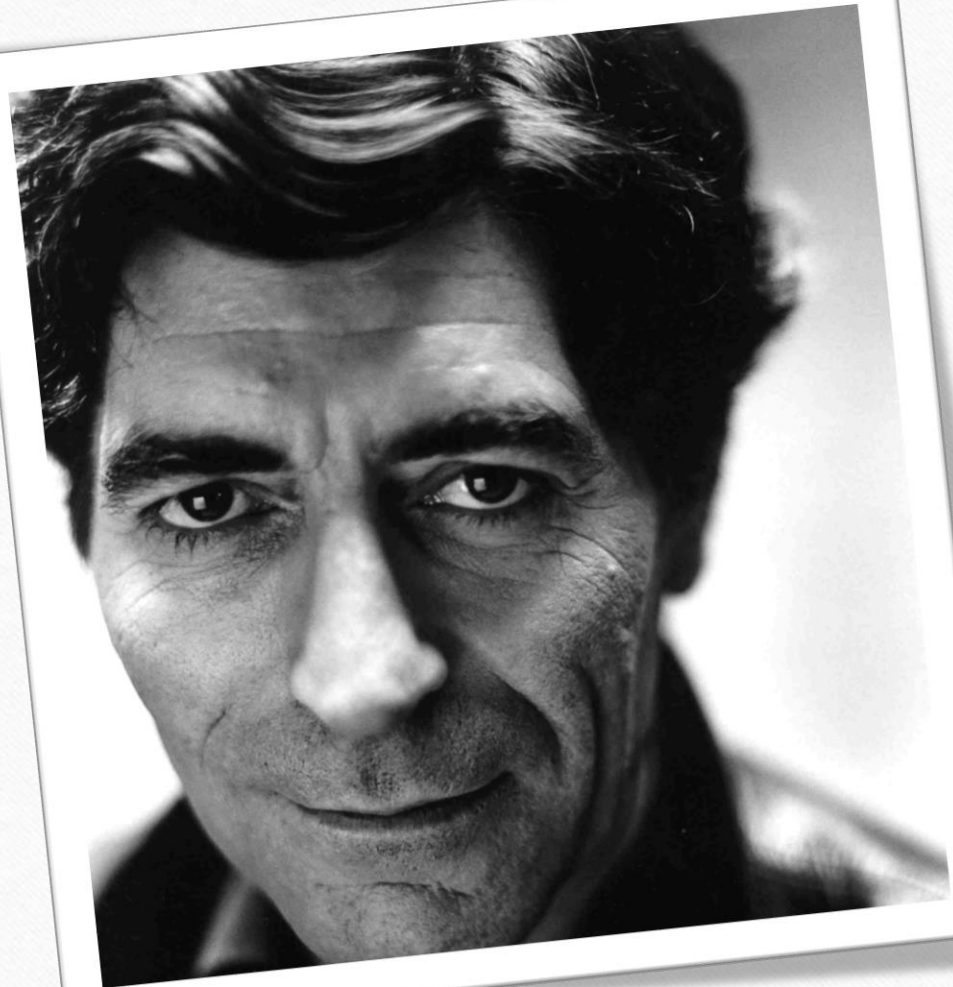

In 2013 he received the Prince of Asturias Award for literature.



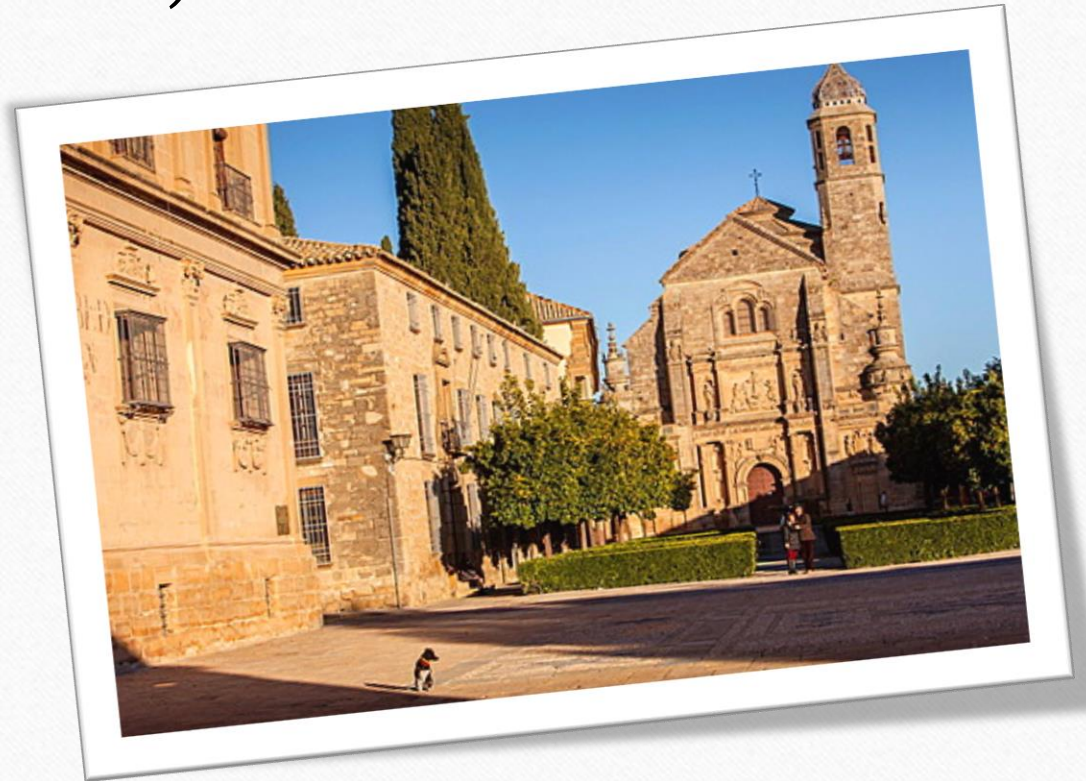


# The most important --- monuments

Built according to the plans of Diego de Siloé by Andrés de Vandelvira and Alfonso Ruiz.

# Palacio de las Cadenas

Built for Juan Vázquez de Molina by Andrés de Vandelvira. Since 1873. serves as town hall
