Beekeeping Museum
- the exposition located in the area of **Včelárska paseka**, founded in 1930, exhibits unique collections of hives used as early as the 17th century, box hives of various types from the 18th century, whose greatest promoter in Slovakia was Juraj Fándly.



Kostolná pri Dunaji

An Oasis of Siberian tigers

The oasis is located in the protection zone of Slovak nature near the town of Senec, less than 3 kilometers from the village Kostolná pri Dunaji.



The main goal of this project is to save at least one population of the Ussuri tiger from extinction.

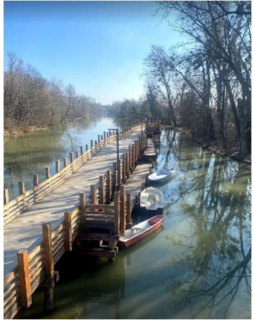

Interesting Places in Senec District



Zálesie

Korzo Zálesie - Wooden promenade along the Little Danube with a smaller lookout tower. This promenade offers beautiful views of the corners of the Little Danube, where you can

watch the surrounding nature in peace.



Malinovo

A trip to the **Hniezdo lookout tower** or **Bobri hrad** is actually an easy walk along the Little Danube. No big elevations, no difficult sections, just a short walk.



Ivanka pri Dunaji

The monument of General Milan Rastislav Štefánik is a memorial place on the outskirts of the village, a symbolic monument on the place where he tragically died. The monument was built in 1923. It is in the shape of a pyramid according to the project of the famous architect Dušan Jurkovič.



The Manor House was built in the Rococo style in the 18th century for the Grassalkovich family.

At the beginning of the 20th century, it was owned by the Huňady family and the manor house was renovated.

At present, the manor house has been renovated and houses mainly two institutions: the Loyola Jesuit Center for Spirituality and the Anton Neuwirth College



Bernolakovo

In village Bernolakovo you can visit few interesting places. There is a **baroque mansion Theresia Chateau** built by Jozef Esterházy in 1714 - 1722. The surroundings of the château offer sport and leisure options (golf, tennis, paintball, fishing and more).



Čeklís Castle stands on a hill on the outskirts of Bernolákovo. It was built in the 13th century and disappeared at the end of the 15th century. There is a waterworks in the area, it was built in the style of a castle tower. A secret underground passage led from the castle to the Biely kameň castle.
