## **Course Description**

In this course, participants will come to understand the idea behind Flipped Classrooms and how to integrate it into their own classroom curriculum. The Flipped Classroom has been defined as a pedagogical model in which the typical lecture and homework elements of a course are reversed. Short video lectures are viewed by students at home before the class session, while in-class time is devoted to exercises, projects, or discussions.

The "Flipped Classroom" is a new method of teaching which allows students to do homework in class and what is considered traditional class work at home. Often, short lectures, mostly in the form of videos or podcasts, are viewed by students before class starts. Flipped (upside down) Classrooms focus on active learning and student engagement, giving the instructor a better opportunity to deal with mixed levels, student difficulties, and differentiated learning styles during class time.

By the end of this course, participants will be able to confidently implement a "Flipped Classroom" lesson and will have gained the confidence to effectively prepare a Flipped Classroom lesson plan.

# Learning outcomes

- Understanding the components of a Flipped Classroom and how to successfully implement it in class.
- Confidently create 'lectures' through the use of various media methods.
- Guide students on an individual and group basis in class.





- Understand how to assess a Flipped Classroom project.
- Create a Flipped Classroom lesson plan.
- Brainstorm ways in which the Flipped Classroom can be implemented cross-curricular or school wide.

# **Target Audience**

- Teachers (primary, secondary, vocational, adult, special needs);
- Teacher trainers; Careers officers, educational guides and counsellors;
- Head teachers/principals/managers of schools/organisations offering adult education;
- Other (Paid or voluntary) management staff in the institution/organization.

## **Duration of training**

1 Week, 30 Hours

## Programme (Day by Day)\*

#### **MONDAY**

Presentations and Warm up games; Understanding what the Flipped Classroom is and looking at some Flipped Classrooms in detail; Establishing ways in which the Flipped Classroom can be implemented; Brainstorming your own Flipped Classroom project.

# **TUESDAY**

Building 'lectures' for the Flipped Classroom; Understanding how to create videos for students and where to upload and store them; Explore other Flipped Classroom teaching methods through blogs, messenger and other social media platforms.

## **WEDNESDAY**

Understanding how to manage group work; Consulting with students and groups; Creating rubrics and student portfolios.

## **THURSDAY**

Creating a detailed Flipped Classroom lesson plan.

## **FRIDAY**

Finishing up the Flipped Classroom lesson plan and assessment rubric. Brainstorming cross-curricular or school wide Flipped Classroom learning in your school.

Full day excursion
